

## CLUB CHATTER

Today we welcome Luton Town once again to London Road. With 21 points from 30 games the Hatters are again fighting to avoid the relegation bogey. With no League match for the past two weeks we ourselves are looking for points to bring us within striking distance of the promotion seeking clubs. We now have 32 points from 29 games and are 7 points behind Hull City, who are second in the table and have played 2 more games than ourselves.

Now to look back to last Saturday and that great F.A. Cup triumph over Arsenal. This will be looked upon as probably the greatest game at London Road and certainly the greatest achievement in the history of our club. Congratulations have been pouring in from all quarters on the great performance put up by our lads. The Arsenal Club themselves were very profuse in their praise for our performance. They do not hesitate to say we well deserved our win which was achieved on football ability. Arsenal supporters—what a good crowd they were!—were very much impressed with our facilities at London Road, and although naturally disappointed with the result they enjoyed their visit. Some of them stayed to the Supporters' Club Dance in the evening and really made a day of it. By beating Arsenal in

the 4th Round of the Cup, before a 30,000 crowd and a £9,000 gate, we have created four new Club records: (1) we have reached the 5th Round of the Cup for the first time; (2) beaten a First Division Club in competition football for the first time; (3) created a new gate record and (4) the highest gate receipts in the history of our club—not a bad day's work!

The 30,000 crowd are to be congratulated on their first class behaviour. It is pleasing to be able to report no major accidents apart from the expected minor fainting cases, etc., the St. John Ambulance were not too hard pressed. The crowd packing, whilst much better than on previous big matches, still leaves something to be desired. There were certainly places on the terracing where more spectators could be accommodated, but again we were faced with the difficulty of blocked gangways. For our 5th Round match a new experiment will be tried out. We are issuing different coloured tickets for each of the three sets of Ground Turnstiles (London Road End, Moys End and Glebe Road Side), and spectators will only be allowed through the appropriate set of turnstiles. This will mean that many supporters using London Road end turnstiles will for this match use the Glebe Road turnstiles (at the Arsenal match


