Goalkeeper :

COLIN TINSLEY. His first Club being Grimsby Town, then on to Exeter City before joining Luton in August, 1963. He made several appearances in the First Team last Season.

Full-backs :

FRED JARDINE. Played for Dundee for two Seasons before coming to Luton at the end of Season 1960-61. Played as an outside-left last Season, was successfully played as a full-back.

Half-backs :

GORDON FINCHAM. Transferred from Leicester to Plymouth, and then to Luton in 1963. Is the dominating centre half who has proved his value at Luton.

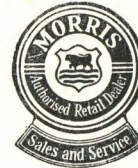
