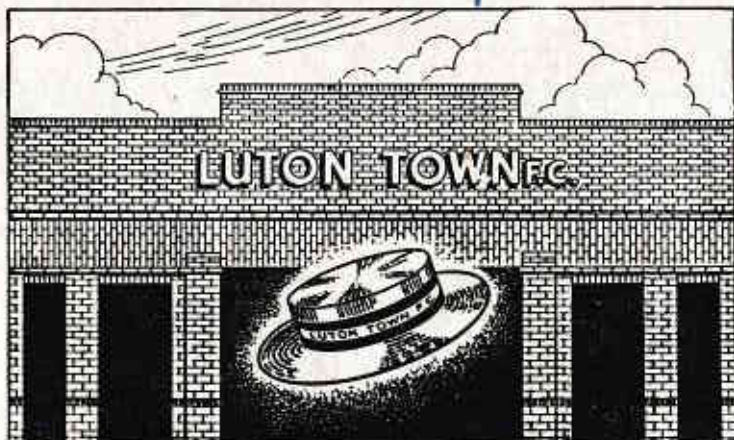

Club Notes

WITH the fervent and heart-felt wish that better things are around the corner for the Club, we welcome supporters to another new season.

Optimistically, we feel that better things are in store, but we have scarcely been helped by some recent happenings, most serious of which is the accident to David Pleat on Wednesday.

Going into a tackle with Dick Edwards in a practice match, he went down heavily and, on X-ray examination, was found to have fractured a bone in a leg which cannot mean other than a lengthy absence.

Other injuries, of a more minor character, threatened to complicate the job of team selection for today's match which we are desperately anxious to win.

One can only hope that further injuries do not occur today because, on Monday, we face the long trip to Wrexham and also have to field a reserve team at Leyton Orient.

Supporters should note that the proposed parking restrictions on the Dunstable Road side of the ground are not in operation yet, so, for the moment, the problem which we feel sure can be surmounted by alternative arrangements, has not arisen.

Not by our choice, but through an alteration in the rules of the Football League, the minimum price of admission has now gone up to 4/-. There has been no increase for other parts of the ground and there is now free access between the Kenilworth Road terrace and

the Bobbers Stand so that supporters now have their choice of standing in the open or under cover.

This afternoon, during the interval, the draw takes place for the Ford Anglia car which is given every 10 weeks under our Pools scheme.

Will supporters please note that today's tickets are for a new, improved scheme which offers £630 a week in prizes. From Monday to Friday, daily, there will be one prize of £25 and six of £5 and £100 in 5s. I.O.U's. Then, on Saturdays, there is the football competition with £100 for the three highest scores, £25 for the next highest, £20 for the next against and a £10 accumulator for three teams each scoring four goals.

In addition, the draw for a car every 10 weeks will continue. All this for one shilling a week ! Agents are wanted and the one selling the winning car ticket will receive £100.

There is a warning from the F.A's World Cup Organisation that tickets for the series next summer are going quickly and that those who intend buying them should not delay in making their applications (not to this club because our closing date has gone).

Applications for 10 match season tickets which include a semi-final, the third and fourth place final and a chance to go into the ballot for a ticket at the final should be made to the World Cup Organisation, White City, London. Applications for season tickets in the lesser categories should be made direct to the grounds where the games will take place.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

John Hardie (goalkeeper). Born in Edinburgh and previously with Chester. Joined Bradford in Season 1963-64. Only missed one game last season.

Alex Gordon (right back). Signed immediately prior to the present season after plenty of experience in Scottish First Division football with Dundee United.

Gerard Lightowler (left back). A local boy who previously played in junior football with St. Bedes Old Boys. Joined us in October 1957 becoming a professional in November 1958. Was originally an outside left but was later converted to a full back which has now become his recognised position.

Paul PAnson (right half). Born at Shipley and was with Shipley Town when taken on the Park Avenue ground staff. Now a full professional and showing great promise.

Donald McCalman (centre half). Born at Greenock and was with Hibernian before making the journey south to Bradford. Played mainly at full back during his first season but took over the pivotal berth in season 1960-61 and has been a tower of strength to the side. Made 155 consecutive League appearances from 27th February, 1960 to 26th August, 1963.

Peter Flynn (left half). Joined Bradford in 1957 after service with Leeds United. For several seasons his opportunities at Park Avenue were limited but has now made his position secure. A good ball player with a powerful shot.

Sam Lawrie (outside right). Signed from Charlton Athletic on 26th October, 1962, at a substantial fee. Was with

Charlton for six years and before that Middlesbrough for five and a half years.

Kevin Hector (inside right). Originally regarded as an outside right, was converted to an inside forward, a position which seems to suit him and in which he has performed with considerable distinction. Kevin who is 20 was born in Leeds and came to us via the South Leeds Club. Leading goal scorer for the last 3 seasons. Has attracted the attention of First and Second Division Clubs.

Jim Fryatt (centre forward). Southampton born but was secured by Bradford during the 1963 close season from Southend United for whom he played for three seasons. Scored 11 goals in Season 1963-64 and 16 goals in Season 1964-65.

R. S. Ham (Bobbie) (inside forward). Another local boy who was on our books as a professional from September 1960 to June 1963. After a spell with Gainsborough Trinity and Grimsby Town was brought back to the club by our Team Manager who feels that this player is still capable of giving some good service to the Club.

Ronnie Bird (outside left). Born Erdington and joined Bradford during the 1961/62 close season from Birmingham City. Has a good turn of speed and good ball control. Has been watched by First and Second division clubs.
