UNFORTUNATELY, the team's run without defeat which was beginning to capture the imagination of the fans, came to an end on Wednesday at Trannere, a ground on which many high hopes have foundered in the past.

However, it should be emphasised that our lads did not go down without a fight, as is shown by the fact that there was no score until a quarter of an hour from the end.

Then, the Rovers secured the vital first goal and added another before the team had recovered from what was, after all, a crushing blow in a hard fought match of this nature.

One defeat, of course, is far from being disastrous and, to a large extent, we were insured against such an eventuality by returning with both points from Port Vale last Saturday.

Then, after a goalless first half in which the defence played well, the forwards prospered from the fact that the wing-halves gained a grip in midfield and the points were gained a little more comfortably than the 2-1 score would indicate.

Certainly, the result at Trannere has done nothing to affect thoughts which have been growing these last weeks, that we can emerge as real, live promotion prospects and, naturally, there are hopes that the team will be victorious and decisively, against Halifax Town this afternoon.

For the Yorkshire team, who have been struggling away from home this season, this is a first League visit to this ground and we give them and their well-known manager, Willie Watson, of

England football and cricket fame, a warm welcome.

This is our last League match before we start in the F.A. Cup competition next Saturday with a visit to Romford where we certainly do not expect an easy passage.

Romford are a successful Southern League club, number many experienced players in their ranks and there is no question of our players thinking that they will be able to coast through this game, which will be approached with all the seriousness and determination that have been shown recently in the struggle for League points.
