



CLUB NOTES

SEASON'S GREETINGS—The directors, officials and players would like to take this opportunity of wishing all our spectators the compliments of the season, including the best of everything in the New Year. Our club's fortunes have taken a turn for the better during the second half of 1965, so here's hoping that this continues during the whole of 1966.

FIRST LEAGUE MEETING—This afternoon we extend a warm welcome to Luton Town who are paying their first league visit to Haig Avenue—the return meeting will be at Luton to-morrow, when our Reserves entertain Bacup Borough (kick-off 3 p.m.). Our only other meeting with Luton was in September, 1962, when they came here in the second round of the Football League Cup and beat us 3-1. In those days Luton were in the Second Division. Luton are better placed in the table than ourselves, as they have 23 points from 20 games, three more than us. Seven of these points have been gained on tour from victories at Rochdale (2-1) and Port Vale (2-1), and draws at Bradford City (2-2), Doncaster (1-1) and Lincoln (2-2). Luton have scored 42 league and five cup goals, their marksmen being O'Rourke (14), Reid (11), Whittaker (nine), Moore and Stark (three each), McKechnie and Gibson (two each), Rioch (one) and two "own goals."

F.A. CUP ARRANGEMENTS—We are still not in a position to announce arrangements for the third round F.A. Cup game with Ipswich Town at Haig Avenue on January 22nd. The matter has been discussed by the board and consultations at the time of going to Press, were taking place with Ipswich. It is, however, hoped to make an early announcement in the local Press.

LUTON TOWN F.C. — PEN PICTURES 1965/66

COLIN TINSLEY. Born at Middlesbrough, his first club being Grimsby Town, then on to Exeter City
before joining Luton in August, 1963. He made regular appearances in the first team
last season.

RICHARD EDWARDS. Signed amateur forms in October, 1963, and gained his place in our Combination
side immediately. He was offered professional terms in June, 1964, and we look to him
now to establish himself as a regular.

FREDDY JARDINE. Born in Edinburgh. Played for Dundee for two seasons before coming to Luton at
the end of season 1960-61. He came as an outside-left, but was successfully converted
to a full-back.

JOHN REID. Previously played for Bradford and Northampton to whom a substantial transfer fee was
paid in November, 1963. He has settled down well at Luton and is a tireless and
energetic worker.

MATT WOODS. A native of Skelmersdale. His first club was Blackburn Rovers for whom he made 126
out of a possible 128 appearances, including a Cup Final, before going to Australia in
1963. Upon his return to this country, Luton secured his services.

BRUCE RIOCH. Although born at Aldershot he was brought up in Luton. Had trials for the England
Schoolboys team. He signed apprentice professional in August, 1963, and full professional
in September, 1964.

FRENCH. Signed professional in October last.

BARRY FRY. Was signed during the summer on a two months' trial. Born in Bedford he represented
England both as a Schoolboy and a Youth International. Previous clubs were Manchester
United and Bolton Wanderers.

JOHN O'ROURKE. Was previously with Arsenal and Chelsea, from whom we signed him on a free transfer
in December, 1964. He immediately made his mark at Luton and scored 22 goals in 23
League appearances for us. He has also played for London Schoolboys and the England
Youth Team.

BILLY HARBER. Joined Luton from Swindon on a free transfer in September 1964. Although his home
is in Stepney, he was born practically on Luton's doorstep at Hitchin.

RAY WHITTAKER. A Londoner from Bow, his only other club being Arsenal. He gained England Youth
International honours with John O'Rourke in 1962 and 1963, and joined us in March, 1964.
