OF necessity, these notes had to be written before yesterday's match at Southport in which all connected with the club were hoping fervently that the team would get back into winning form.

Certainly, it was a great disappointment to be beaten by Bradford City, though it is a fact that the team played well enough to have won comfortably and failure was in the inability to make the most of several scoring chances that were created.

It was unfortunate that the team should have to take the field without the captain, John Reid, whose covering in defence was missed and also Graham French. Both players were injured in the previous match at Stockport, but it was thought that both would be available for the holiday matches.

These mishaps, together with those to Billy Harber and Jimmy Gibson came after a spell of freedom from injury and we can only hope that two matches on consecutive days have not brought further problems of this sort.

For the players, it has been a holiday shortened by the necessity to make the long journey to Southport on Sunday in readiness for yesterday's match after which there was a hurried rush back south to be ready for the return.

This is scarcely the ideal arrangement at this time of the year, although, of course, we realise the difficulties with a preponderance of northern teams in the Fourth Division.

This will be Southport's first visit to this ground and our only previous meeting with them was at Haig Avenue some three years ago in the League Cup when we gained a narrow victory.

We welcome them and in particular, Billy Bingham, who was such a popular figure here after joining us from Sunderland during our more palmy days. He will be remembered as the scorer of the goal that put us in the 1959 Cup Final and, of course, was a member of the team on that great occasion.

Unfortunately, his playing career was cut short by a serious injury with Port Vale and last week Southport appointed him their team manager after he had spent some months with them as their trainer-coach.

Southport's recent form has demonstrated that they cannot be treated lightly and it was a great performance on their part to win their Cup replay at Stockport. Then, they went on to confirm the form by taking two League points from the County.
