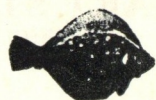

### Introducing our visitors, LUTON TOWN

**Goalkeeper**—COLIN TINSLEY. Born at Middlesbrough, his first club being Grimsby Town, then on to Exeter City before joining Luton in August, 1963. He made regular appearances in the first team last season and established himself as first choice.

**Right Back**—GORDON RIDDICK. Turned professional in April 1961 following a short period of apprenticeship. Much is expected of this lad as he gains more experience. He has already made several first team appearances.

**Left Back**—FREDDY JARDINE Born Edinburgh. Played for Dundee for two seasons before coming to Luton at the end of season 1960-1961. He came as an outside left but was successfully converted to a full back, where he figured last season in 32 first team games.

**Right Half**—JOHN REID. Previously played for Bradford and Northampton to whom a substantial transfer fee was paid in November 1963.

**Centre Half**—ALAN RIVERS. Born at Portsmouth, he migrated to the Luton area and was recommended to Luton F.C. in 1961. Progressed through the Junior teams and signed full professional forms in January 1964.

**Left Half**—JOHN MOORE A newcomer to Luton, having been signed from Motherwell in May 1965. He was recommended by Luton's Scottish Representative who forecasts a bright future for him in English football.

**Outside Right**—GRAHAM FRENCH. Started his career with Shrewsbury, transferred to Swindon and Watford for large fees. A youth international joined Wellington Town and in October returned to League football at Luton.

**Inside Right**—TONY READ. Born at Haydock. His first club was Sheffield Wednesday and in 1964 he left them to go to Peterborough for whom he played at centre forward and goalkeeper. He was transferred to Luton in March 1965 but unfortunately, owing to a broken bone in his foot, he was unable to play last season. With his adaptability on the field, it remains to be seen which will prove to be his better position.

**Centre forward**—JOHN O'ROURKE. Was previously with Arsenal and Chelsea from whom he signed on a free transfer in December 1964. Immediately he made his mark at Luton and scored 22 goals in 23 games. Has also played for London schoolboys and the England youth team. Last season he was dogged by injuries.

**Inside Left**—BRUCE RIOCH Although born at Aldershot he was brought up in Luton, and first attracted attention when playing for Luton schoolboys. He also had trials for the England schoolboys team. Signed apprentice professional in August 1963 and full professional in September 1964.

**Outside Left**—RAY WHITTAKER A Londoner from Bow, his only other club being Arsenal. He gained England youth international honours with John O'Rourke in 1962 and 1963, and when Luton were in need of a left winger he was persuaded to join in March 1964. He went straight into the first team and held his place for the remainder of the season.

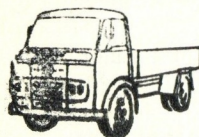

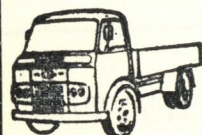

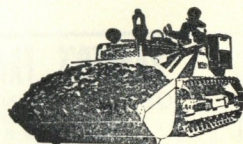
