Club Notes

WITHOUT any doubt at all, today's match against pace-setting Torquay Utd. is a vital stepping stone in our fight to regain promotion to the Third Division and our hopes of doing so this season will look bright if the team can continue its recent successful run and achieve a convincing victory.

Not that it will be easy because Torquay, managed by former West Ham wing half, Frank O'Farrell, have been in the limelight in the leading positions in the table since the start of the season.

Not since 1937 have they paid a visit to this ground and that was a memorable occasion for us because victory in that final match of the season, watched by a crowd of 20,000, gave us promotion to the Second Division. Perhaps that can be regarded as a happy augury for today's task.

Unfortunately, the team had a wasted journey to South Wales on Monday when on arrival at the Newport ground, it was found that the referee has ruled that the pitch was too badly waterlogged for the match to go on.

As a result, the fixture list at the end of the season becomes further congested and the date we have suggested to Newport and just about the only one available, is Monday, April 18th. We await their confirmation of this.

This afternoon, our good wishes go to Luton Schoolboys in facing their stiff task at Leeds in the quarter-final of the English Schools' Shield.

Should a draw be the result and there will be a report in tonight's "Green 'Un", then the Committee have three dates for which to negotiate the replay on this ground.

First could be next Thursday evening, failing that, next Saturday morning or it could go on, on Wednesday week. An early announcement will be made in the local press.

An innovation by the Bobbers Stand and Supporters Club is a competition to find their own beauty queen with a view to going forward to the area final of the National Supporter's Club competition as Miss Luton Town F.C. An entry form is on page one of this programme in space kindly donated by Messrs. Williams and Richardson and the choice will be made at a social at the Bobbers Stand Club on March 30th.


