VICTORIA GROUND CHATTER

This afternoon we welcome Luton Town, a side going very strongly for a place in the Third Division next season.

Three weeks ago we met in the League game at Kenilworth Road, with Luton emerging winners by the odd goal in three.

We defended well that day, and although Luton had more of the game territorially, we finished strongly and might well have had a point in the final 15 minutes.

We are hoping to go one better today, but it is not going to be easy against a side which has taken 12 points from the last 16 matches, winning their last four games in a row including a victory over Torquay United last Saturday.

Luton's record, however, is not as impressive away as it is at home and we are hoping for two points to help our efforts to escape the bottom four.

We must keep picking up points regularly if we are to avoid trouble. We have a great advantage in finishing with a run of four home matches that should enable us to pull clear with a little luck.

We beat Aldershot convincingly enough on Saturday, although it was not a great game to watch. But the important thing is that we gathered the points and improved our goal average against a team who are struggling just as much as ourselves.

The news of Amby Fogarty's suspension came as a shock this week. We did not expect anything like a fortnight. He will miss the two important games against Newport (away) and Torquay United (home).

John Gill is settling down well at centre-half and there is not much doubt that he has made a good deal of difference to the strength of the defence, which is now probably as effective as any in the division.

Pen Pictures — LUTON TOWN — Season 1965-66

COLIN TINSLEY. (*Goalkeeper*) His first club was Grimsby Town then to Exeter City before joining Luton in August 1963.

GORDON RIDDICK. (*Full Back*) Turned professional in April 1961 following a short period of Apprenticeship. Tall, with good ball control and a very good shot.

FREDDY JARDINE. (*Full Back*) Played for Dundee for two seasons before coming to Luton at the end of Season 1960-1961.

JOHN REID. (*Half Back*) Previously played for Bradford and Northampton to whom we made a substantial transfer fee in November 1963.

MATT WOODS. (*Half Back*) His first club was Blackburn Rovers for whom he made 126 out of a possible 128 appearances, including a Cup Final, before going to Australia in 1963. Immediately upon his return to this country Luton secured his services.

JOHN MOORE. (*Half Back*) A newcomer to Luton, having been signed from Motherwell in May, 1965.

TOMMY McKECHNIE. (*Forward*) Came here direct from Rob Roy (Scotland) at the end of Season 1960-1961.

JOHN O'ROURKE. (*Forward*) Was previously with the Arsenal and Chelsea. He immediately made his mark at Luton and scored 22 goals in 23 league appearances for us.

BRUCE RIOCH. (*Forward*) First attracted our attention when playing for Luton Schoolboys. He signed Apprentice Professional in August 1963 and Full Professional in September, 1964.

RAY WHITTAKER. (*Forward*) His only other club was the Arsenal. He gained England Youth International Honours with John O'Rourke in 1962 and 1963 and joined us in March 1964.

DAVID PLEAT. (*Forward*) Luton paid a big fee to Nottingham Forest at the beginning of the 1964-65 season. He played for the England Youth team along side O'Rourke and Whittaker.
