

Club Notes

THERE have been some critical Easters for us in the last few years, but for a vastly different reason than the one of which we are bang in the middle today.

Now, we are fighting, and with a considerable amount of success, for a place in the Third Division as the first step towards re-establishing the club as a power in the land.

There is a long way to go because, after today, eleven matches still remain to be played in rather less than five weeks and that is going to impose a strain on all concerned.

However, we are convinced that we have the resources to meet the problem, despite the fact that the remaining programme calls for a mid-week match every week.

Of necessity, these notes had to be written before the result of yesterday's match at Colchester was known, but the team went hopeful of success on the ground where they won a friendly match before the season began and Layer Road is a ground on which we have attained a fair amount of success.

As you entered the ground today, I hope you noticed that the St. John's Ambulance Brigade were holding their annual collection to help their funds. It is hoped that our supporters gave generously to this appeal, for little need be said for the good work the Brigade always does, and the Directors would

like to express their thanks for the help given to this Club.

As has been the case several times this season, we are entertaining this afternoon, new opposition in Darlington to whom we offer a warm welcome.

They are, or were, before yesterday's games, immediately above us in the League table and have been making a determined bid to improve their status.

A fortnight ago, representatives of the club watched them at Aldershot where they impressed as a workmanlike side, with a centre forward in Joe Cummings, formerly of Newcastle United, who is a real source of danger.

Before he moved from the United, we had an interest in Cummings but, at that time, he regained his first team place with Newcastle and was not available for transfer.

After that, the need for signing a new leader had evaporated and we did not pursue that line of enquiry. However, he has done extremely well for Darlington whose list of scorers he leads by a comfortable margin.

Undoubtedly, this match assumes great importance and the one on Monday when we stage the return with Colchester may be even more vital. There is certain to be a strong following from the Essex town and few of our supporters will want to miss this clash, so the result should be a bumper gate.
