

Club Notes

WHILE on Saturday, we welcomed opposition who were strange to us, in Darlington, today we entertain old friends and rivals in Colchester United.

Managed by Neil Franklin, former England and Stoke City centre half, they accompanied us into the Fourth Division at the end of last season and are, with us, among the seven from which the four to go back into the Third Division is most likely to come.

Before the season began, we went to Colchester for a friendly match which we won 2-1, but things change in the course of eight months and Neil has welded Colchester into a most formidable combination.

Included in their ranks is Ted Phillips, who had a brief spell with us after having been signed from Leyton Orient late last season in what proved to be a futile bid to avoid further relegation.

Phillips has done well for Colchester who are his home town club, but he cost them a point last Saturday week when he failed from the penalty spot against Wrexham.

We have first hand evidence of the power of his shooting and his opportunism and it scarcely need be said that a careful watch will be kept on him this afternoon.

Since these notes were written, the team has played two vital matches and, by now, the promotion situation will be a whole lot clearer than it was last weekend when we had a fruitless journey to Halifax.

Fruitless, not from the result point of view but because winter suddenly returned to the north and our party found the game snowed off when they arrived at the ground.

This was just the last thing we wanted because of the already over-crowded programme and the match will now have to be fitted in during May because we are already fully committed with mid-week matches during this month.

After today, we face two away matches which could turn out to be stiff hurdles. First, next Saturday, is against the County at Nottingham, whose early season promise has not quite been fulfilled and then, on Monday, we make the long trek to Newport for the second time for the re-arranged fixture with the County.

This was postponed on February 21 because of the waterlogged state of the Somerton Park pitch.

Altogether, it is a hectic period and our fervent wish is that we shall keep more clear of injuries than has been the case recently.
