Beswick, Keith (goalkeeper). Born Cardiff. Before signing for Newport played for Millwall. Made a number of 1st Team appearances last season.

Williams, David (full back). Born Newport. Has been with the Club for a number of years.

Bird, John (full back). Joined the Club as an amateur on ground staff and signed professional in November 1957. Born Cardiff.

Rowland, John (wing half). Born Newport. He was an amateur with the Club from 1951-54. A professional with Lovell's Athletic from 1957-58. This player is also an under 23's International.

Rathbone, Graham (centre half). Was an amateur on ground staff, but signed professional forms in 1960. Born Newport. Since signing professional forms he has been a regular 1st Team player.
