Club Notes

ONLY once previously have we had the pleasure of welcoming this afternoon's opponents, Bradford, to Kenilworth Road in the Fourth Division and that was on the opening day of last season when we won 3-1.

However, the history of the meeting between the Clubs goes back much further than that, to the years immediately before and after the war, when we were both enjoying happier times as members of the Second Division.

A similar result to that of last season would be a tonic for us after a spell of six matches without a victory, though Bradford are in slightly worse circumstances because their run without a win is one match more.

There were hopes that, for us, the turn of the tide had come at Chester last Saturday when the first away point of the season came our way in a goalless draw, but some of the gilt was knocked off that by the 2-0 setback at Newport on Monday.

Apart from the recent inability of the forwards to get among the goals recently, they are not enjoying the best of luck and in each of the last two matches, shots worthy of goals, struck the woodwork at vital times when the scales might have been tipped firmly in our favour.

At Chester, Bruce Rioch was the unlucky marksman, while it was the turn, at Newport, of Ray Whittaker, who crashed the ball against the bar when the score was only 1-0 against us.

Providing ground conditions are suitable, there will be a display of new Vauxhall models this afternoon by Messrs. Shaw and Kilburn and, included

in the procession will be the Viva car which will be the subject of our periodic draw at half-time today.

In this respect, supporters are asked to note that, beginning today, new Pools tickets will be on sale. These are the double type ticket which were issued up to some time ago and offer excellent value for one shilling, incorporating as they do, both the numbers and football competitions.

Next week, sees the showing at the Odeon Cinema of the complete film of the World Cup, 1966, which no football enthusiast will want to miss. Officials and players of this club have been invited by the Odeon management to see it on Monday evening.

Next Tuesday evening, we visit Watford in the F.A. Youth Cup and, if a replay is necessary, it will be here on Monday week, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

On Wednesday week, Bedfordshire will be meeting Berks, and Bucks, in the Southern Counties Amateur Championship, kick-off 7.30 p.m.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

John Hardie (goalkeeper). Previously with Chester. Joined Bradford in season 1963/64. Ever present last season. Born in Edinburgh.

Findlay McGillivray (right back). Born Newton Grange. Previously with Third Lanark 1959/64 and then with Rangers 1964/66. Should be well suited to English conditions and style of play.

Gerard Lightowler (left back). A local boy who previously played in junior football with St. Beded Old Boys. Joined us in October 1957 becoming a professional in November 1958. Was originally an outside left but was later converted to a full back which has now become his recognised position.

Michael McGrath (wing half). Born Dublin and was with the Home Farm Club when recruited by Blackburn Rov. with whom he stayed 12 years and has also made 21 appearances for Eire.

Kenneth Taylor (centre half). Signed in March 1965 from Huddersfield Town for whom he played in 250 Football Leagues games. Played for England v. Australia in the 1964 Test at Leeds.

Alex Gordon (wing half). Signed immediately prior to the 1964/65 season after plenty of experience in Scottish First Division football with Dundee United. Started as a full back but has developed into a most efficient half back.

Philip Robinson (winger). Born Skellow nr. Doncaster previously with Huddersfield Town 1960/61 and Doncaster Rov. 1961/66.

Bobbie Ham (inside forward). Another local boy who was on our books as a professional from September 1960 to June 1963. After a spell with Gainsborough Trinity and Grimsby Town was brought back to the Club by our Team

Manager who felt that this player was still capable of giving some good service to the club. This was borne out last season when he scored 23 League goals.

Peter Madden (centre forward). Born in Bradford and was with St. Athony's Junior side and also played for Bradford Minor Eleven in the County Competition.

Willie Rodger (inside forward). Born Dalkeith and played for Newton Grange Star before joining Bradford near the end of 1964/65 season. May well be another Ian Gibson.

Geoffrey Gould (winger). Born Blackburn. Signed for Bradford at 15 and became a full professional at 17. Good ball player.
