

VIEW FROM THE TERRACE

VALE'S 1-0 WIN AT ALDERSHOT last Saturday—their first in eight games—set a lot of tongues wagging and not all of them were exactly ecstatic in praise. The fact remains that Vale won two points and a huge boost in morale which should stand them in good stead. This barren spell was ended by a smart application of defensive tactics which demanded absolute dedication from every player. Some may call it negative. But for Vale the result was positive.

How good this victory can be indicated by Aldershot's previous record. Until Vale's arrival they had not been beaten at home in 16 games and had not failed to score in front of their own fans all season. And just to put one fact straight—Vale's goal did not come from a wild clearance out of our defence, as some reports say—it was started by a shrewd, along-the-carpet push in midfield by Terry Miles. John Ritchie crossed perfectly and Billy McCartney got his first goal for Vale with a brilliant flying header.

There was another encouraging result in mid-week when Vale's Northern Floodlit League Side beat Halifax Town 3-1. Happiest man of all on the night must have been Jackie Mudie, who celebrated his first game of the season with a goal and a display of generalship which added lustre to Vale's young and talented outfit. The two goals by Micheal Cullerton were absolute beauties, Jackie certainly scotched rumours that his playing days are ended.

Vale will be keen to-day to wipe out the memory of last season's encounters with Luton, who for a long time looked strong promotion contenders. They beat Vale 2-1 at Vale Park and handed the Burslem club their most embarrassing hiding of the season at Luton—on Cup Final day—by winning 5-0. It would be a tonic indeed if the scores could be reversed this afternoon.

OUR VISITORS . . .

THE LUTON TOWN Football Club was founded in 1885 and was reputed to be the first club in the South to employ professional players.

They played in the Southern League from 1894—96 and were elected the following year (1887) to the Football League Division Two. Known as the 'Hatters' or the 'Straw Plaiters'.

Luton were in Division Two from 1897 to 1900 when they failed to gain re-election. They then operated again in the Southern League until 1920 when they were elected to the Third Division and in 1921 were members of the Third Division South.

They gained promotion to the Second Division in 1937 after being runners-up the previous season and in 1955 were runners-up and of course were promoted to the First Division where they remained until season 1959-60. After a short spell in the Second Division they were relegated with 29 points; only winning one game away from home and losing 17 — the remaining three away games were drawn.

Season 1963-64 found Luton in the final position of eighteenth with 42 points; the following season they were relegated with 33 points. Last season, their first in the new Fourth Division, they finished sixth from the top with 56 points, missing promotion on goal average. Tranmere and Colchester had the same number of points and Colchester were promoted.

Luton have been quarter finalists in the F.A. Cup on two occasions — 1933 and 1952. Their team in 1952 was Stretton; Cooke, Aherne; Horton, Owen, Watkins; Davies, Taylor Moore, Stobbart, Mitchell.

In season 1936-37 Luton scored 103 goals in 42 matches, and of this number Joe Payne scored 55 which was then a record for the Division 3 South. In the previous season the same player made history on his debut at centre forward by scoring 10 goals in a Third Division South Match against Bristol Rovers whom they beat 12-0.

NOTICE

TO

PLAYERS, OFFICIALS AND SPECTATORS

(Extract from Rules)

Players, Officials and Spectators are only allowed to take part in or attend matches on condition that they observe the Rules of the Association, and every affiliated Association or Club is required to observe and enforce such rules.

Every Association or Club is responsible to the Council for the action of its Players, Officials and Spectators, and is required to take all precautions necessary to prevent Spectators threatening or assaulting Officials and Players, during or at the conclusion of Matches. An Official of an Association or Club, Referee, Linesman, or Player, shall not bet on any Football Match, and Associations and Clubs are also required to prevent betting and the use of objectionable language by Spectators. In the case of a breach of this Rule, any Player, Official, or Spectator may be removed from any ground, and such force used as may be necessary for the purpose of effecting such removal.

The Association shall be entitled to publish in the public Press, or in any other manner it shall think fit, reports of its proceedings, acts and resolutions whether the same shall or shall not reflect on the character or conduct of any Club, Official, Player, or Spectator, and every such Club, Official, Player, or Spectator shall be deemed to have assented to such publication.



PEN PICTURES OF PLAYERS

for Season 1966 - 1967

GRAHAM FRENCH (Winger)

Born at Wolverhampton. Graham came into prominence when playing for Shrewsbury and whilst with them he gained Youth International caps for England. Later he played for Swindon and Watford, before joining Luton in October, 1965. Can play on either wing.

ERIC GRIEVE (Half Back)

His birth place is the Scottish town of Gatehouse-of-Fleet. Was last season playing for Tarff Rovers, Kirkcowan as an amateur and was persuaded to try the professional game in July, 1966.

FREDDIE JARDINE (Full Back)

Although born in Edinburgh, he played for 2 seasons for Dundee before coming South to Luton in 1961. Was signed as an outside left but has since made the left back position his own.

JOHN MOORE (Wing Half)

In his second season for Luton. Previously played for Motherwell. Made 43 League appearances and scored 5 goals last season which can be said to be a satisfactory baptism into English football.

DAVID PLEAT (Winger)

Born at Nottingham. He played for England Youth Team and also Nottingham Forest, from whom we secured his transfer in August, 1964. Was a regular member of our first team until he had the great misfortune to break a leg. Now recovered, he is determined to make his presence felt once more.

TONY READ (Goal Keeper)

Born at Haydock. His first club was Sheffield Wednesday, and in 1964 he left them to go to Peterborough. Was then transferred from there to Luton in March, 1965. To show his versatility, he last season made 35 appearances in the forward line, scoring 12 goals besides 6 appearances in goal.

BRUCE RIOCH (Inside Forward)

Although born at Aldershot he was brought up in Luton and represented the Town at school, also having trials for the England Schoolboys' team. He signed apprentice professional in August, 1963, and full professional in September, 1964. Made 21 League appearances last season.

ALAN SLOUGH (Full Back)

Another Luton boy who has graduated through the ranks of Schoolboy, Amateur and Apprentice Professional, being offered full terms in May, 1965. Can also play with distinction at wing half and inside forward

TONY THEAR (Centre Forward)

He was born at Tottenham and joined their neighbours, Arsenal as apprentice professional. He can also play at centre half, and whilst at Highbury his appearances were divided between these 2 positions. He holds an F.A. Youth Cup winners' medal.

BOBBY THOMSON (Full Back)


