PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Willie Mailey (goalkeeper). A former Scottish Schoolboy International who started his career with Everton before moving to Gresty Road on 15th March 1963. Made his debut in the League side during the 1963/64 season. A very agile keeper, an ever present last season and recently completed 100 first team appearances. Born Duntocher.

Ralph Marshall (full back). Now in his third season at Gresty Road after joining them from Glasgow Rangers. A young player with 61 first team appearances to date. Born Airdrie.

Tom Lowry. A young full back signed from Liverpool during the last close season. Recently came into the League side and shows much promise.

Albert Harley (half back). A close season signing, formerly with Shrewsbury Town and Swansea Town, but was on loan to Guildford last season. An attacking player and is proving to be a most useful acquisition.

Eric Barnes (centre half). First played for the Club as an amateur whilst serving with the R.A.F. and signed professional forms on completion of his National Service. Made his first team debut on 1st February 1958 against Hull City. Although most of his appearances which total 271 have been at centre half, has also played at wing half and full back.

Mick Gannon (half back). Joined the Gresty Road staff during the 1964/65 Season and soon established himself in the League side. Has also had experience with Everton and Scunthorpe United from which club he came to Crewe. Born Liverpool.

Peter Kane (outside right). Joined the Crewe staff from Northampton Town in March 1964. An experienced player who has had two spells with Northampton Town and also with Arsenal. Has played in all the inside forward positions. Last season leading scorer with 16 goals. Born Glasgow.

John Archer (inside forward). A new recruit to the staff joining Crewe from Bournemouth on September 27th and played the same day against Exeter City. Was formerly with Port Vale. A good ball player who should prove to be a useful acquisition.

John Regan (centre forward). Formerly with Shrewsbury Town and Brentford and signed for the Club on 4th November. Made his debut against Aldershot last Saturday and scored in this his first game for the Club.

Johnny King (inside forward). Born Wrenbury. Started his professional career with Crewe but moved to Stoke City in September 1953, from Stoke he joined Cardiff City but after one season there rejoined Crewe in June 1962. A very clever ball player who is equally at home at centre forward or inside forward. 189 appearances since rejoining the club.

Peter Gowans (outside left). Born in Dundee. Now in his fourth season at Gresty Road after previous service with Celtic. Made his League debut in October 1963 against Walsall and scored on his debut. Over 100 first team games and is usually amongst the goals.

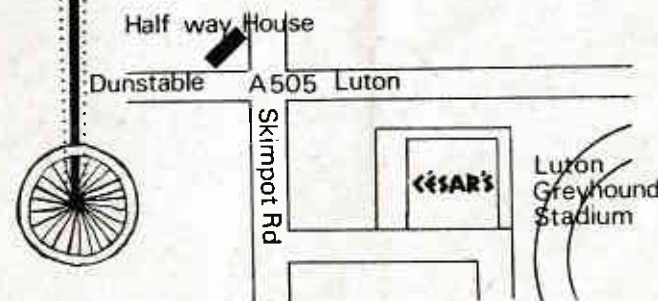
