### Club Notes

After our spell of away matches which, disappointingly, have not enabled us to improve our position in the League table the chance to gain home points comes this afternoon when Chesterfield, friends of ours of long-standing from our first spell in the Second Division, are the visitors.

If our team plays as well and as successfully as in last week's Cup replay with Exeter City, then there will be many satisfied customers and, also, assuredly, the desired result.

Unfortunately, the Cup success left its trail of injuries which undoubtedly had a disastrous effect on the team for last Saturday's League match at Lincoln.

Because of this Frank Conboy, who is still not fit, and Ray Whittaker, had to stand down, and there were three or four others who probably would have been given a rest had our playing resources been such as to allow it.

Prominently in this category was Tony Read, who turned out, even though he still had four stitches in a gash at the back of his head.

In the circumstances, perhaps, defeat was not unexpected, but certainly no one could have anticipated one of such severity as 8-1. This was our heaviest post-war reverse and it is perhaps significant that five of the goals came in the last 18 minutes when the strain of two hard matches in heavy conditions in less than 48 hours began to tell its tale.

Certainly, it is a reverse that everyone connected with the club will want to forget as speedily as possible, but there were these mitigating circumstances and

it is something that is unlikely to be repeated.

However, it is perfectly plain that some reinforcement of the playing strength is a vital necessity and Manager Allan Brown has been devoting most of his energies this week to trying to bring this about. When these notes were written, he was still not without hope of landing a newcomer in time for today's match.
