Club Notes

EVEN now, even a week after the event, it is difficult to think of last Saturday's match at Bristol without a feeling of acute disappointment, because there is no doubt that our interest in this season's Cup competition should not have ended there.

It is true that a couple of mistakes completely out of character from the general display, in the critical closing stages, were the root cause of our dismissal, but it is also true that we were desperately unlucky not to progress, without even the necessity of a replay.

Had we secured a well-merited second chance, then the prize would have been a home match with Arsenal and no one needs reminding of the tussles we had with this opposition in the past and what crowd-pullers they always were.

However, that is now merely a dream of what might have been, and we are jerked back to the reality of the League programme and the drive the team is making to vastly improve their position in the League Table.

Full points from fine displays in the last two home matches have improved things considerably and, even now, we are not without hope that a late run will put us close to the promotion ~~challengers~~ if not actually among them, though this is by no means a complete impossibility.

Shrewd signings made by Allan Brown since he took over the management have repaired most of the deficiencies that existed before and he was hoping to secure another new player yesterday.

This was designed to provide cover for the goalkeeper position which has caused some anxiety at times this season

because only one experienced player was available for it.

If things have gone according to plan, Ron Swan, of Oldham Athletic, a 6 ft. 2 ins. tall Scot, will be our player by the time these notes are read. If that is the case, then the manager will be feeling reasonably certain that he has duplicated satisfactorily every position in the team.

Our Visitors today, Barnsley, are friends of long-standing and it is good to see them enjoying greater prosperity on and off the field. So far as the former is concerned, we shall be doing our best to bring their recent good run to an end, and a convincing win would be a tonic for the hard task that awaits us at Stockport next Friday evening.

Dismissal from the Cup has left us with a blank in our programme for 28th January and efforts are being made to bring forward our visit to Southend which was arranged originally for Monday April 24th.

If that is not successful, then it is likely that we shall contact Hartlepools United about the possibility of bringing forward our visit to them which, at the moment, is due on Good Friday.
