## CLUB NEWS AND VIEWS

**Manager's Comments.**—Now that all the excitement of the F.A. Challenge Cup has died down, on behalf of those connected with the Club I would like to thank all spectators who have so handsomely supported the team. The thousands who travelled to Brighton last Wednesday night certainly made themselves heard and such support really encourages the players to greater effort.

The result at Brighton was, of course, a great disappointment, but whilst the "Shots" did not have one of their greatest days, no one can deny that they gave 100% effort and at times, particularly after **Ronnie Walton** had scored, looked as though they were going to equalize. All we can do now is to wish Brighton continued success in their quest for the Cup. The gate was 29,208 with record receipts of £6,239 8s. 0d. Now what we have to do is to try and improve our league position, because this is the most important part of the programme. With this issue in mind we take on today Luton Town. The Bedfordshire club has not got an inspiring record this season but have improved considerably of late. Their away record is bad with just two draws from fourteen games played.

### Pen Portraits.

**Ronnie Swan.** (Goalkeeper). A Scot, signed this season from Oldham Athletic, previously with East Stirling.

**Bobby Thomson.** (Right Back). Another Scot who first came into prominence with Partick Thistle. Signed for a big fee by Liverpool and joined Luton in Aug. 1965.

**Freddie Jardine.** (Left Back). Born Edinburgh and played two seasons for Dundee before joining Luton as an outside left in 1961.

**Alan Slough.** (Right Half). A Luton boy who graduated through the ranks of school-boy, amateur and apprentice professional. Signed full time in May 1965.

**Maxwell Dougan.** (Centre Half). Signed from Leicester City this season, previously with Third Lanark.

**John Moore.** (Left Half). 2nd season with Luton. Last played for Motherwell.

**Graham French.** (Outside Right). Born Wolverhampton. Gained Youth International cap whilst playing for Shrewsbury, later played for Swindon and Watford. Joined Luton in 1965.

**Derek Kevan.** (Inside Right). Several times capped for England. Previous clubs West Bromwich Albion, Chelsea, Manchester City.

**Gordon Riddick.** (Centre Forward). Turned professional in 1961. Born Langlebury. Luton his only club.

**Bruce Rioch.** (Inside Left). Born in Aldershot. Had trials for England Schoolboys, apprenticed in 1963, turning full professional in September 1964.

**Ray Whittaker.** (Outside Left). Londoner from Bow. Service with Arsenal. Gained Youth International caps in 1962 and 1963. Signed March 1964.
