THERE is a specially warm welcome for this afternoon's visitors Southport, because their manager, Billy Bingham, was with us during our hey-days as a brilliant, Irish International outside right and along with our present manager Allan Brown, was in our attack at Wembley in the 1959 Cup Final.

Billy's playing days were ended prematurely when he broke a leg whilst playing for Port Vale whom he joined from Everton, the Club from whom we received a substantial fee and two players, John Bramwell and Alec Ashworth, for his transfer.

Southport gave him his first chance on the managerial side and he has repaid them by building a team that is making a brave bid for promotion this season.

Whilst we wish him the best of luck in this aim, we mean to ensure that such hopes do not gain a boost as the result of today's match and the home form of our team encourages the thought that there will be another Luton victory.

That every possible home point is needed, does not need stressing, in view of the continuing disappointing results on away grounds.

Yet, the form of the team in these matches, up to the point of securing the all-important goals, has been distinctly encouraging although, of course, it does not compensate for the acute shortage of points on away grounds this season.

Last Saturday's story at Exeter was once again one of our team enjoying almost complete superiority in midfield and not being able to carry it further than that. Even Exeter officials admitted that they had been very fortunate to

win, but that is small consolation when points are so urgently needed.

Maybe, the break through will come next Saturday when we visit Nottingham to meet the County, another team who are in the danger zone and we have particular reason to wish for victory here because the County are one of two teams to win on this ground this season.

Those who follow the Reserves should note that they will be at home to Aldershot on Wednesday evening kick-off 7.30.

When, last season, the Bobbers Stand and Supporters Club chose a Beauty Queen for the first time to go forward to the area finals of the National Federation of Supporters' Clubs Football Queen a great deal of interest was caused.

Choice of this year's Luton queen will be made at the Bobbers Club at a Social to be held on Monday, March 13th, and young ladies in the area are invited to enter.

Brian Reeves (goalkeeper). Born Ormskirk. Had experience with Burscough and Blackburn Rovers, in second season at Haig Avenue.

Alex Parker (full back). Born Irvine, Scotland. Scottish International. Signed from Everton, October 1965. Club Captain.

Kevin Cairns (full back). Signed from Dundee United, but born Preston. An experienced player in our team since summer, 1962.

Arthur Peat (wing half). Born Liverpool and secured from Everton five seasons ago. Had a Benefit match last season.

Fred Molyneux (centre half). Signed at the beginning of last season, this Wallasey born pivot has had previous experience with Liverpool. Missed only one game last season.

Colin Atly (wing half). Only Southport born player on the books, was previously with Preston. Signed summer, 1964, had a few outings at centre forward, scoring 11 goals.

Dick Marshall (winger). Ex-Leicester City. Born Burbage, near Leicester, was signed July, 1965.

Alan Spence (inside forward). Top goal scorer last season with 23 goals, was signed from Darlington, July, 1962. Born Seaham. School Teacher.

Jim Fryatt (centre forward). Secured from Bradford Park Avenue last March, this experienced attack-leader was slow to fit into the side but scored 5 goals by the end of the season. Born Southampton.

Alex Russell (inside forward). Yet another ex-Everton player, was secured in October, 1963 and has proved to be one of our best captures. Another North Eastener, being born in South Shields.

Ronnie Smith (winger). An experienced Liverpool born player who was an ever present player last season. Joined us

July, 1965 from Port Vale where he played alongside our present Manager, Billy Bingham. Has also been with Crewe, Bournemouth and Liverpool.

Tommy Roberts. New signing from Stockport County, born Liverpool.

John Price. Another new signing, born Consett, his previous club was Leeds United.

William Eric Redrobe. (centre or inside forward). Born Wigan, spent four seasons at Bolton Wanderers.

David Farrar. Born Manchester. Another of the new pre-season signings, secured from Manchester United. A part timer.


