## CLUB NOTES AND COMMENTS

It is time to say that the British climate is a changeable one. Last season, many of our games took place in pouring rain, making it extremely uncomfortable for both supporters and players. This season we have been much more fortunate, having mainly fine days, but this has been offset by the strong swirling winds which have been with us during the last month. The game against Lincoln City was yet another when these conditions prevailed. The ball does many unusual things and can often be carried to an unexpected position, catching both defenders and forwards unaware.

Injuries again deprived us of the services of our regular wing forwards, Peter Gowans and Billy Dearden. Additionally, Johnny King was not fit, the result being that the forward line contained two regular centre forwards, John Regan in his normal position and Ian Sandiford at outside right. Also, Graham Matthews, recently at centre forward, was on the left wing.

At the time of writing, it is difficult to say whether all the players came through unscathed against Lincoln City. Whilst several players needed attention during the game, Peter Leigh came in for some really nasty knocks. They say it is tough at the top, and if Wednesdays game is anything to go by, it certainly is.

Now that we have come through the Lincoln game with maximum points we come to our next hurdle, the visit of Luton Town. At home, Luton have a similar record to our own, having won 11, drawn 5 and lost 3 with a goal average of 36 for and 20 against. Away from home it is a far different story, having won 1, drawn 2 and lost 16, scoring 11 goals and conceding 45, the highest goals against in the Division and only Lincoln City, with 10 goals, have scored less.

However, we bid the 'Hatters' a warm welcome for this evenings game.

Next Wednesday evening we have another first team fixture when our visitors are Barrow, this seasons outstanding away side, having gained maximum points in 11 away games. This really should be an exciting game, with, we hope a gate worthy of such a fixture.

*Goalkeeper* RONALD SWAN Born Pleat. Formerly with East Stirling and Oldham where last season he played 35 first team games

*Right Back* BOBBY THOMSON Born at Menstrie in Scotland. He first came into prominence with Partick and was later transferred to Liverpool for a big fee. Luton secured his services from the latter club on the 2nd August, 1965.

*Left Back* FREDDIE JARDINE Although born in Edinburgh, he played for Dundee for two seasons before coming to Luton in 1961. Was signed as an outside left but has since made the left back position his own

*Right Half* FRANK CONROY Born Marylbone. Signed recently from Chelsea where he had graduated through the junior sides.

*Centre Half* MAXWELL DOUGAN Another recent acquisition from Leicester where he played mainly in the reserve side. Has also played with Third Lanark.

*Left Half* JOHN MOORE In his second season with Luton. Was previously with Motherwell. Made 43 appearances last season scoring 5 goals, which can be said to be a satisfactory baptism into English football.

*Outside Right* GRAHAM FRENCH Born at Wolverhampton. Came into prominence when playing for Shrewsbury and whilst with them gained Youth caps for England. Later he played for Swindon and Watford before joining his present club in October 1965.

*Inside Right* KEITH ALLEN Born in the Isle of Wight and went from Stockport to Luton when Derek Kevan went to Edgeley Park. Has already got on the goal mark.

*Centre Forward* BRUCE RIOCH Although he was born at Aldershot, he was brought up in Luton and represented the town. Made 21 appearances last season.

*Inside Left* GERALD KING A Welshman, he played for his country both as a schoolboy and at Youth level. Has played for Cardiff and Torquay from whom he was transferred in June 1966.

*Outside Left* RAY WHITTAKER A Londoner from Bow, his only other club being the Arsenal. He gained England Youth caps in 1962 and 1963 and when we were in need of a left winger he was persuaded to join us in March 1964.

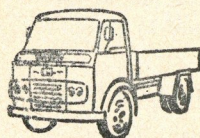

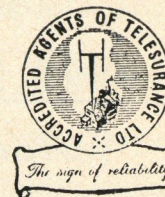

### SUPPORTERS' JOTTINGS

Luton Town, tonight's visitors, will be paying only their third visit to Gresty Road. In the opening home fixture in the Third Division in season 1963/64 we won 1-0 and last season we were again successful, winning 2-0. At Luton, we still have to gain our first victory, only once have we gained a point. That was in a 3-3 draw in season 1963/64 when Frank Lord scored a hat-trick.

Whilst searching through some old papers, some of the results of our wartime games came to light and some of those results were quite startling. This was in 1943 and many of the clubs at present occupying First Division status were our opponents. Amongst them were Stoke, Everton, Manchester United, Manchester City, as well as Wolverhampton, Huddersfield and Derby County. There were also our near neighbours Chester, Wrexham, Stockport County and Southport. Saturday 28th August saw us win at Molyneux 4-2. The scorers were Malcolm 2, Blunt and Tagg. Saturday 6th November, 1943 was Huddersfield 8 Crewe 0. Price scored seven of their eight goals and in the home game the following week Price again scored just one but this was sufficient to ensure victory. Later that month Crewe visited Goodison Park and drew 5-5. Two other games are worthy of a mention. On 13/3/43 Crewe beat Stockport 8-3. The Crewe scorers were Boothway 5, Malam 2 and Waring 1. On the 17th April, Gresty Road saw the scoreline Crewe 8 Wolverhampton 1. The scorers were Dyer 4, Anderson 1, Malam 1 and the left winger playing as A. N. Other 2. These were evidently the days of attacking football.

Back to present days and an odd note to start off with. Now that the re-arranged game with Lincoln has taken place, and as only this last result will appear in the record book, we can erase the only home game in which we had failed to score.

Just nine games remain in this season's fixtures and we still await our first player to reach double figures. Leading contenders are Gowans 9, Matthews 8, Sandiford 7, Regan 7 and Bradshaw 6.

The Railway end of the ground has now been receiving attention from the forwards. Four goals have come there in the last two games thus reducing the lead that the Gresty Road end had held for such a long spell.

### Junior Supporters Notes

Bookings are now being taken for the organised outing to Barnsley. Book early and avoid disappointment.

The next meeting of the Junior Section will be held on Thursday next, April 13th at the Sportsmen's Club, Gresty Road, which incidentally is just six years to the day since our first ever meeting was held.

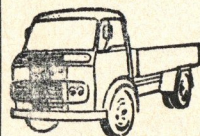
