Club Notes

EVEN though it was costly in terms of casualties, the point gained at Wrexham on Saturday represented a splendid start to the season for us and gave a very clear indication that the team will be a vastly different proposition away from home than it was last season.

In fact, on Saturday's showing, few teams will hold the Welsh side on their own ground and the pleasing feature from our point of view was the fighting spirit that was so plainly evident even when we were unfortunately reduced to nine men.

The goal Rodney Green scored in the 88th minute, his first in a competitive match for the Club was also the first we had scored on the Racecourse ground in four visits.

Tonight, Green will have the opportunity to shine against former colleagues, Charlton Athletic whom we welcome as our visitors in the League Cup.

Of course, Charlton are old friends from our days in the higher sphere and there has always been a friendly relationship between the two clubs.

Saturday's result which confirmed the good form shown by the team in the successful pre-season trials, should have whetted the appetites of the supporters and we are hoping for a big crowd and also on Saturday when Barnsley, a much improved side, will be the visitors.

It is unfortunate that injuries, the most serious of which are to Max Dougan and Brian Johnson, should weaken the resources available to Manager Allan

Brown, but he is confident that he will get over this somewhat sticky patch.

This programme takes on a new look in that it includes the Football League Review a publication that is rapidly becoming popular.

Although this magazine retails at 1/- the club have decided to include it free of charge and without raising the charge of the programme.

At the moment, this is an experimental move in the hope that increased sales will help us to cover the extra charge to us.

In weeks when the first team is away, the Review can be obtained by ordering it from newsgents, or in case of difficulty from the distributors, Vernon, Holding Partners Ltd., 43-44, Shoe Lane, London E.C.4.

It will also be on sale at the Supporters Club's shop underneath the main stand which is worth a visit because they have many interesting items on sale, including club badges and programmes from other clubs.

Starting shortly will be a new jackpot scheme to operate on Saturday afternoons only when tickets will be sold by attractive girls in white sweaters and black skirts. Fifty per cent of the money taken, will go back to supporters in prize money which will be paid immediately after the match, and the draw will be made at half-time.

Finally, we welcome the new players who have joined us, also the trainer/coach, Dennis Evans, from Arsenal, and the new club doctors, Drs. Buckingham and Burrows and wish them a very happy association with the club.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

C. Wright (goalkeeper). Glasgow born player whose first professional club was Glasgow Rangers. Was later with Workington, then Grimsby Town, from which club Charlton secured him for a big fee in March, 1966.

B. Curtis (full back). Seventeen year old from Langwith, who joined Charlton straight from school and became a full professional on his 17th birthday. Made his League debut against Preston in March, 1967.

I. King (full back). Comes from Lonehead, Edinburgh and gained Scottish International honours as a schoolboy. Was secured from Leicester City in March, 1966.

P. Reeves (half back). A local youngster who played for Kent and London as a schoolboy. Captained England's Youth team in Turkey in May, 1967, reaching the final of the Junior World Cup.

B. Kinsey (centre half). Born at Charlton and was once a Bromley amateur. Club captain. Played at outside left and wing half before settling down as centre half.

J. Keirs (half back). A Scot from Ayrshire, who was signed in July, 1965. Made his League debut the season before last and is only 20 years of age.

G. Moore (winger). Born in Glamorgan and has played for Wales in youth and full Internationals. Signed for Cardiff in 1958, Chelsea in 1961, Manchester United in 1963, Northampton in December 1965 and became a Charlton player in May, 1967.

K. Peacock (inside forward). Born at Dartford and joined Charlton straight from school. Has since made over 100 League appearances.

A. Campbell (centre forward). A Scot from Arbroath, who joined Charlton in 1964 and made his League debut a year later. Scottish Youth International.

P. Went (inside forward). Cost Charlton their biggest ever fee when they secured him from Leyton Orient in June, 1967. Born in London and is an England schoolboy and youth international—was with Peter Reeves in the England Youth team in Turkey last May.

L. Glover (winger). Born at Kennington, London and joined Charlton straight from school. Made his League debut at centre forward in September, 1962.


