### Club Notes

There is no gainsaying the fact that the team have made a highly satisfactory start to the new season and, to date, have not suffered defeat in five matches.

The fight back on Wednesday against Charlton Athletic in the League Cup was a thrilling affair and but for the brilliance of goalkeeper, Charlie Wright, there would have been no necessity to go into a replay.

This has now been arranged for next Wednesday evening, kick-off 7.45, instead of the original date of Tuesday which meant a clash with nearby Millwall who are at home to Huddersfield Town. The winners will visit Leeds United in the 2nd Round.

On the second half showing in which the team showed so much fighting spirit, they can go into the replay with confidence and there certainly was no sign of the fact that two divisions separate the clubs.

Incidentally, the crowd of 9,001 was bigger than any we housed during last season and would seem to confirm the fact that interest in football in the town is greater at the moment than it has been for some time.

We are hopeful of an attendance of similar proportions this afternoon when Barnsley are the visitors. There is a long history of meeting of the two clubs, going back to pre-wars days when we first gained promotion to the Second Division and both are now ambitious to regain some of the ground that has been lost in the meantime.

Early last season, Barnsley were in very low water indeed, with a string of defeats debited against them and gates down to an uneconomical level.

An enterprising entry into the transfer market improved matters all the way around, gates shot up and, with something to spare they avoided the dreaded necessity of having to apply for re-election.

The fact that there has to be a replay of the League Cup tie has produced a problem in that the Reserves are due at Colchester on the same evening and the Essex club have declined to re-arrange the match.

Billy McDerment was able to make his first appearance in a competitive match on Wednesday and the fact that he and John Moore passed late fitness tests eased the situation considerably.

Incidentally, the inclusion of the Football League Review in our official programme has been a popular move because every copy was sold on Wednesday evening.

This is a step in the right direction because the price of the programme has not been increased and extra sales will help considerably to offset the extra expense which we have undertaken.


