We shall have to be careful with Luton

IT IS probably no more than symptomatic of the crash-bang of modern soccer fixtures in these islands that we shall have had a very fair taste of cup football before this month is out on top of the opening burst of twice-a-week League fixtures.

We had scarcely got the European Inter-Cities Fairs Cup Final here against Dinamo Zagreb, those worthy winners, here last Wednesday night before we had to fly off from Yeadon to Southampton for a League game and, all in a week, here we are back in cup football, the Football League Cup third round variety, against old friends and opponents, Luton Town.

they were also among our numerous (too numerous) F.A. Cup conquerors since the war, too. In the middle 1950's they beat us up to the First Division by a year, being promoted in 1955. But in 1960 they had to descend again although not before they had showed the football world that a "little" club can get to Wembley. They won their way to the 1959 Final, and lost it only 2-1 to Nottingham Forest.

WELL DONE, SYD

As you all know, the chap who is now our chief coach, Syd Owen, was their manager, captain and centre half in those days, and how he combined all the work only Syd knows, bless him. It was a wonderful achievement by Syd, let alone the worthy club he was with.

However, "The Hatters," to give Luton their old nickname—born of a one-time straw hat industry in the town, have had leaner times since those glorious days when they were the toast of all Bedfordshire.

It must never be forgotten that, especially in these days of quick transport, they live almost in the shadow of the two famous crowd-pulling North London clubs, Spurs and Arsenal, and that inevitably many people living in Luton and liking top soccer go "up to town" for it at White Hart Lane or Highbury.

BRIGHT START

Luton come to us tonight as a Fourth Division side. They finished last season in the bottom half of that division, but they have made a bright enough start in this League Cup by ousting a Second Division outfit—Charlton Athletic, and at Charlton, too. The sides drew 1-1 at Luton in the second round, and Luton produced one of the surprises of the round by winning the re-play 2-1 at The Valley.

So, while we hope to go one better in result than we did in merely drawing last week's cup tie with Dinamo Zagreb we shall clearly have to be careful, for all our superior League status.

NOT JUST "MERELY"!

We used the phrase "merely" about our draw with Zagreb, but we think the great bulk of British sides would be very glad "merely" to draw against such a

clever, strong and beautifully drilled team, and an awful lot beside ourselves would have to give best to them. Don't forget they beat Celtic at Parkhead last season, and Celtic went on to win the European Cup as well as a few other trophies.

Nobody is sorrier than ourselves that once again we have run second, and so continue to brood that we have won nothing, but we certainly lost the Fairs Cup Final to a really fine side by any standards anywhere.

And it was without its "star," inside forward Lamza, for both the Zagreb and the Leeds games!


UNSINKABLE TRACTORS

These Leeds-built Track-Marshall crawlers are fitted with specially lengthened and broadened tracks, so that they exert a ground pressure of only 2.4 lbs per sq in. They were ordered by the Forestry Commission for work on water-logged ground in remote areas. Each tractor has a special cab fitted with an *escape hatch*, in case the driver gets that sinking feeling!



DESERTS CONVERTED WHILE YOU WAIT!

Fowler tractors are being used in the West Punjab by the Pakistan Government to convert sunbaked infertile desert into wheat-bearing soil. The tractors first break up the baked solid earth with their rippers, then build 3 foot embankments with their dozers around each 2 acres. These bunds, as they are called, are intended to conserve moisture.
