Club Notes

AFTER the disappointment and frustration of the last two Saturdays, we are hoping for considerably better things today, including, of course, another handsome victory over our opponents from the far north-west, Workington.

In the past we have crossed paths rarely with Workington, who are comparative newcomers to the League and our first meeting with them was way back in 1955 when we beat them 5-0 in a Cup-tie here.

There have been only two League meetings, in 1964-65 when we lost by the only goal in Cumberland and drew 0-0 at Kenilworth Road in the last match of a season that marked our descent into Division IV.

Then, on Wednesday (7.30 p.m.) we try conclusions with Swansea Town who, like Workington, were in Division III last season. The Welsh club are rivals of long standing but, having already taken a point from them at Vetch Field this season, there should be a victory to drive on our promotion ambitions.

It was particularly disappointing to all concerned that last Saturday's game at Aldershot had to be postponed because of the waterlogged ground. Particularly were we sorry for the hundreds of supporters who made the trip but, once again, we would emphasize that the referee is the sole arbiter of the fitness or otherwise of the pitch.

Something else that is beyond our control is the decision of our Cup opponents, Oxford City, not to allow youngsters into the ground at half-price when we visit them on December 9th.


Our allocation of tickets are on sale today and, for season ticket holders in

the first instance, there are seats at 7/6 6/- and 5/- and standing tickets at 4/- will be on general sale.

Some difficulty is being encountered in arranging new dates for the matches with Darlington and Aldershot. At the moment, the proposal is that if neither us nor Darlington are concerned in Cup replays from the first round, Darlington should come here on Wednesday, December 13th, but we are still awaiting confirmation.

Tomorrow is the annual Remembrance Day services at Luton War Memorial, beginning at 10.40 a.m., and the Mayor of Luton hopes for support from every section of the community.






