DULY, though not without some anxiety in the first half when the enforced lay-off caused by the wet weather, undoubtedly showed the mark it had left, the team collected two more points in their drive towards the top of Division IV.

The success against Workington on Saturday was the fifth in succession and kept intact the 100 per cent home record which, certainly, we expect to maintain tonight, when Swansea Town are the visitors.

Our experience against the Welsh side extends over far more years than some of us care to recall and covers meetings in all divisions, except the First.

Not the first team to do so, the Welsh side are finding life in the Fourth Division far from easy and it may now be difficult for them to realise their ambition to jump back into the Third Division at the first attempt.

Before the start tonight, Manager Allan Brown will present to the Chiltern Youth League club, Wardown Rovers the set of new kit presented by Uwin Ltd., and won by us through the Football League Review for our recent performance at Exeter.

There has been a very ready sale indeed of tickets for our F.A. Cup-tie with Oxford City at Oxford on December 9. By last weekend, all 7/6 stand seats were sold and season ticket-holders, who have first option on our stand allocation, are reminded that only a limited number of tickets at 6s. and 5s. remain.

There has also been a heavy demand for ground tickets at 4/-, though there are still plenty left, and Oxford have

intimated that more can be sent for this part of the ground, if required but, positively, no more stand tickets will be available.

Oxford are taking the opportunity of tonight's match to have a look at their opposition and we are expecting a party of 25 of their officials and players.

Also here are representatives of Enfield, who have the Cup task of facing Swansea at Vetch Field.

Supporters should note that if we and Darlington achieve definite results in our Cup-ties, the re-arranged League match will go on at Kenilworth Road on Wednesday, 13th December, at 7.30 p.m.

## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**George Heyes** (goalkeeper). A native of Bolton, and was previously with Leicester City. A very safe and competent goalkeeper.

**Roy Evans** (full back). Welsh International full back, and a dedicated professional. Roy hates to lose, and although not a big player by modern standards, makes up by his determination and grit.

**John Bird** (full back). Fine full back, signed from Newport County in July, 1967. He made over 300 First Team appearances for Newport. A hard rugged tackler.

**Alan Jones** (wing half). Born Swansea. A tall fast attacking wing half, who progressed through the clubs junior teams, a regular player for the 'Swans' First Team last season, also an Under 23 Welsh International.

**Brian Purcell** (centre half). Local product, who has been with the club since a junior. Equally at home at full back. Strong in the tackle, and very quick in recovery.

**Herbie Williams** (wing half). A Welsh International, in the World Cup Games against Greece. One of the few players to wear contact lenses, Williams is tall and particularly strong in the tackle.

**Brian Evans** (winger). Under 23 Welsh International winger. Plays on either wing, and was formerly with Welsh League side Abergavenny. Slightly built but possesses natural ability.

**Keith Todd** (inside forward). Another local product. Under 23 International. Though he is not a big player, his ability and speed, makes him a menace to any defence.

**John Roberts** (centre forward). A son of Abercynon, and a Swansea Town discovery. Once played centre half, but

was successfully converted to lead the attack. Scored 13 goals in 16 appearances at centre forward last season. Another Under 23 International.

**Ivor Allchurch** (inside forward). Wales greatest International inside forward. A record number of caps for Wales—68. Now in his 21st year as a professional. Ivor was once known as the 'Golden Boy' of football. He has never been sent off the field, or reprimanded as a player. Formerly with Newcastle United and Cardiff City. Ivor is spending his second spell with his home club.

**Willie Humphries** (winger). Ex-Irish International winger, who has played for Leeds United and Coventry City, before joining the 'Swans.' With Ivor Allchurch went on the close season tour of Africa, and was the outstanding forward. A native of Belfast.




