Club Notes

AFTER a weekend of prolonged discussion over the re-arrangement of last Saturday's postponed Cup-tie with Oxford City, we were eventually pleased to accept the City's offer to come here and play the game tonight.

In welcoming the Isthmian League amateurs to Kerilworth Road, we appreciate that they must have given considerable careful thought to the problem before coming to their decision on Monday evening to concede ground advantage and play the match here, and we are sure that whatever the outcome of tonight's match, they will find it a rewarding evening.

In the Isthmian League Oxford City made a good start to the season winning six out of their first seven games, but then on meeting some of the better sides like Hendon, Enfield and Leytonstone they faded to only a respectable position in the table, so tonight's match, like their two games with Bristol Rovers last season, could be the highlight of the season for their fans, a large number of whom are expected to be here tonight.

A link with the Town is that up to October this year, Oxford City were coached by a former player of ours. Percy James. Percy was with Oxford City for 14 seasons before he regrettably had to resign because a new job left him with little spare time. At present the team is in the care of committee man, Tony Bricknell.

Among their better known players is goalkeeper John Shippey who is a member of the British Olympic squad and is rated number two in British amateur circles. In addition they have

two members of the Army XI in Steve Morton and former England amateur full back John Harding.

The winners of our game tonight are drawn away to the winners of the Swindon Town v. Salisbury tie, and this is the sixth consecutive occasion that we have received an away draw.

We welcomed a newcomer to our playing staff this week in goalkeeper Billy Taylor from Partick Thistle. Billy started a month's trial period with us on Monday.




