FOR the first time in a fortnight, it is back to the serious business of the search for League points for us this afternoon and, with the visit of Wrexham, our minds go back to the first day of the season when we gained our first point on the Racecourse ground.

That was earned by a late goal from Rodney Green who, unfortunately, has been out of First Team action since the early part of September through cartilage trouble. After an operation, he is in the process of regaining match fitness and full confidence in the Reserves and we hope it will not be long before he is bidding for a First Team place.

Similarly, Brian Johnson is on the way back and it was at Wrexham, when he came on as substitute, that he damaged the ligaments of a knee which necessitated an operation and, like Green, he is fighting his way back to full fitness.

Of necessity, these notes were written before last Thursday's Cup-tie with Oxford City which was finally played on this ground following a week-end of discussion and disagreement.

If we won, then we visit Swindon Town, old rivals of ours, in the Second Round on January 6th, and details of tickets and prices will be made available early next week.

We hope that all those supporters who are in the habit of using our Main Stand, like the new individual seats which have been installed, at considerable expense, to improve the comfort of our fans. The work has been 95 per

cent finished and we feel that it has made a tremendous difference to the amenities of the ground.

Next appearance of the team on this ground will not be until after Christmas when they will have a very attractive Boxing Day fixture with the much improved Bradford team.

Accordingly, we wish all our supporters every good wish for the festive season and would remind them that attractive presents in club ties at 15/6 each are available from the club's offices, the Bobbers Stand Club and the shop under the Main Stand.

PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Livsey (goalkeeper) Born at Keighley in Yorkshire, Gordon moved to Kettering from whom he was recommended to Wrexham by former player Pat Egglestone. He was unfortunate to break his leg in a Cheshire League game last season, but has now made a good recovery and hopes to gain a First Team place in the not too distant future

Schofield (goalkeeper). John was signed from Birmingham City a club with whom he spent ten seasons—firstly as understudy to Gil Merrick and latterly as first choice for their First Team. A great clubman who always gives of his best. Born at Atherstone, Warks.

Showell (right back). Signed from Bristol City on the 12th November 1966, George has had considerable experience with Wolves (where he was understudy to Billy Wright for a number of years). A great clubman from whom a lot is expected during the 1967/68 season.

Stacey (left back). Steve was signed from Bristol City in February 1966 and has been a regular member of the First Team at Wrexham since. A thoughtful player who tries to start attacks from behind whenever possible. Born Bristol on the 27th August 1944.

Beanland (wing half). Tony was signed from Southend United during the close season after having assisted both B'ackpool and Southport. An industrious player who really enjoys his game.

Mielczarek (centre half). Although he carries a Polish name Raymond is one of the few Welsh speaking players on the Club's books. Was born at Caernarvon in February 1946 and after spending a season on the groundstaff he eventually signed professional forms on the 1st May 1964. He is also a Welsh Youth International.

Bradbury (wing half). Another close season signing from Leyton Orient, Terry is an experienced wing half. His

previous Clubs include Chelsea, Southend and Leyton Orient. A hard tackling player who never knows when he is beaten

Carriek (outside right). Born at Ramshaw David was signed by Wrexham at the close of the 1966 season, after having spent three seasons with Wolves.

Griffiths (inside right). One of the most experienced players on the club's books. He originally joined Wrexham in May 1957. Arfon was transferred to Arsenal in February 1961 but returned to his old club in September 1962. An Under 23 International (with Wales), he gets through a tremendous amount of work for one so frail. Born Wrexham.

Smith (centre forward). Still another player who arrived at Wrexham via Southend United. Ray is a tall centre who should cause a lot of headaches to the opposition, particularly in the air where he is at his best.

McMillan (outside left). The most experienced player in the side. Sammy is now in his fifth season with the club. He was signed from Manchester United in December 1963. Has been capped for Ireland.

Evans (inside forward). Another player who has arrived at Wrexham after having seen service with Wolves. Mike was born at Caersws in Montgomeryshire in June 1947 and hopes to make good on his return to Wales.

Weston (centre forward). This will be Don's second spell with Wrexham having left to join Birmingham City in 1960. Since those days he has played for Rotherham United, Leeds United and Huddersfield Town.

Kinsey (inside forward). Albert was transferred to Wrexham from Manchester United in March 1966. A native of Liverpool this player could be a big asset to the Club during this season.




