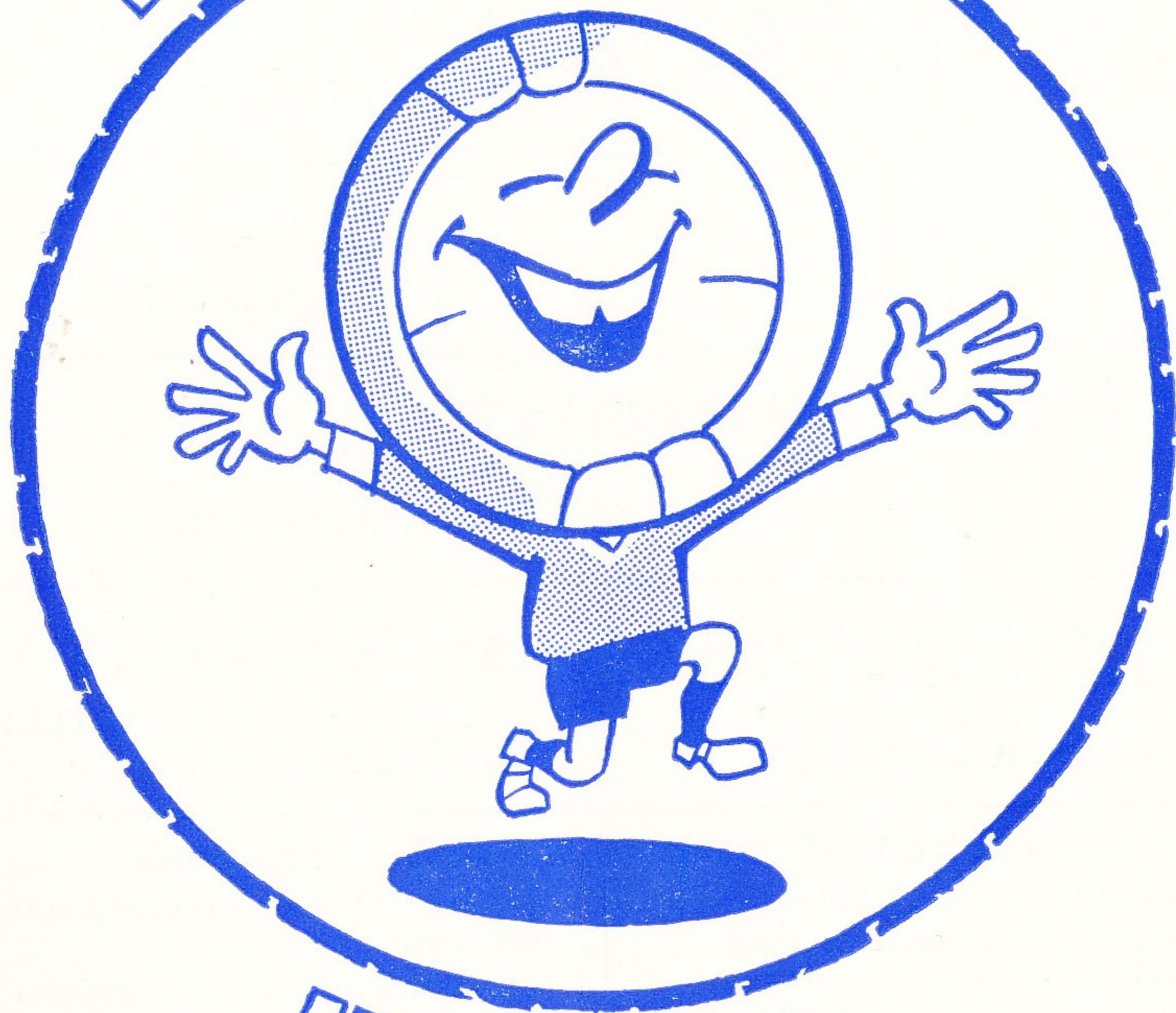

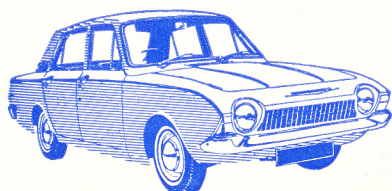

## News and Views

This afternoon we welcome Luton Town who are making their 3rd League visit to the Victoria Ground.

Fortunes have certainly changed for Luton in the last nine years — in 1959 they appeared at Wembley in the F.A. Cup Final, and they were also in Division One until the following year. Last season they finished 17th in the Fourth Division but this season they are challenging strongly for promotion. At present they are placed 4th in the League and have games in hand over the teams above them.

We could not have wished for a better Christmas than to collect maximum points from our holiday games. The win at Darlington recorded our fourth successive win and quite remarkably, completed our third double of the season in those four games. We have now lost only two out of our last twelve League games, having gained 19 out of a maximum 24 points.

The many supporters who made the journey to Darlington were certainly treated to a very entertaining game and it seemed that we had more supporters than the home team when Terry Bell scored his brilliant goal. The vocal encouragement helped our lads when they had to fight back from being 2-1 down in the second half and Ernie Phythian's two late goals made sure the points went to the best team.

The revival, which has lifted us to 7th position in the League, resulted in a good attendance (over 2,500) at the Durham Senior Professional Cup game last Saturday when we completed our third success against Darlington in twelve days.

Our next Fourth Division game is away to Southend United a week today and the following Saturday we are away to Aldershot. After these two tough away games we return to the Victoria Ground on Saturday, 3rd February when Wrexham will be the visitors (kick-off 3.00 p.m.)

On Monday night we shall be playing South Shields in the 2nd Round, 1st Leg of the Durham Benevolent Bowl. The 1st Leg of this tie was to be played at South Shields last Wednesday night, but was postponed due to adverse weather conditions. A new date for the fixture has yet to be arranged.

The records played before the game and during the half-time interval are available from Bruce Moore Ltd., of York Road, and Lynn Street, Hartlepool.
