

They beat us 1-0 on their ground earlier in the season, and we fully expect today's game to be a thriller.

Luton Town have had many ups and downs in their history, which dates back to their entry into the Football League Second Division in 1897-98.

After three seasons, however, they dropped out, and it was not until the Third Division South was formed in 1920-21 that they regained a place.

In 1936-37 they won promotion to the Second Division, and after managing to retain their status they won promotion to the First Division in 1954-55.

Season 1959-60 saw the start of a big slump. With only 30 points at the end of the campaign they slipped back into the Second Division and then into the Third Division after the 1962-63 season.

Their fortunes continued to slip and they became members of the Fourth Division for the start of the 1965-66 season.

They missed promotion at the first attempt on goal-average, and last term they finished 17th.

Next Saturday we have another Fourth Division home game, with Wrexham supplying the opposition. It will be our first clash with them this season as our visit to the Racecourse ground had to be postponed due to the F.A. Cup.

They have dropped out of the promotion race and are now half way down the table, but will not have to be taken lightly.

We are pleased to announce that we have completed negotiations with Blackburn Rovers for the retention of goalkeeper John Roberts for the remainder of the season.

Our thanks go to Rovers for their fine gesture at a time when they were badly hit by injuries and illness to other goalkeepers.


Our Reserves were held to a goalless home draw by Doncaster Rovers Reserves in the North Midlands League Cup last week.
