

CLUB NOTES

WITH three clear-cut home victories and a draw at Barrow, it has certainly been a fine opening to the season for us and we hope to continue this successful run tonight when Barnsley, who accompanied us into Third Division, are the visitors.

One of the best games we had last season was against the Yorkshire team at Oakwell just before Christmas when the result was a 2-2 draw, to complete a bag of three points against this opposition.

As Oldham, Watford and Rotherham United have already plunged to defeat here, there seems every ground for hoping that two more points will be added to the total, especially as Barnsley have made a rather unhappy start by losing two home games.

On the face of things, it looks as if it will be necessary for us to make a forward change because Laurie Sheffield strained a leg muscle in the closing stages on Saturday and it seems unlikely that he will have recovered in time to play.

Following this fixture, comes a difficult, testing spell of three away matches in the course of eight days. On Saturday, we are due at Gillingham, where, doubtless, there will be a big following of supporters and,

next Wednesday, there is the visit to Brighton for the second round of the League Cup.

In the latter game, we are particularly anxious to succeed because we have never yet reached the third round stage.

To round off the busy period, there is a visit to Orient on Saturday week and, again, we expect to take a considerable following.

It is with pleasure that we report that the section of the crowd behind the Oak Road end which has been using foul language, responded well to the appeal made to them by our manager, Allan Brown, before the start of Saturday's match. That led to a noticeable improvement in their behaviour which we hope will continue. As Allan told the crowd. "We do not mind you shouting, but please do not swear."

To avoid congestion and the mixing up of queues, it has been found necessary to alter the location of the boys' or juniors' entrances which, at the Kenilworth Road end are now in Beech Hill Path. At the Oak Road end, there has also been a change and Stewards will be on duty to direct the youngsters to the new entrances.
