

### CLUB NOTES

AFTER two defeats, we are desperately keen to get back on the winning path this afternoon, when Torquay United, who made such a determined bid for promotion last season and failed narrowly to achieve that objective, are the visitors.

They have a vastly experienced team, managed by former West Ham wing half, Frank O'Farrell, and it is not surprising that three former "Hammers" have been holding down places recently.

At the time of writing, it is not known what the composition of our side will be. Unfortunately, we had to go into the League Cup-tie at Everton on Tuesday without Bruce Rioch, who was suffering from gastric trouble and it was earnestly hoped that he would have recovered in time for today's game.

There is no doubt that Rioch's absence was a severe handicap at Goodison Park but, even so, there was plenty of praise for the display of the team and for the way in which they kept on trying to play attractive football.

To the hundreds of loyal supporters who made the long trip, the result must have been a disappointment, but they realised that the team was depleted and that they were meeting one of the best outfits in the country.

Last season, Leeds United, who dismissed us from this competition, went on to win the League Cup and it would not surprise us if Everton emulated them.

First League defeat of the season came at Brighton last Saturday in rather unfortunate circumstances because a scrambling sort of goal just

before half-time, decided it and despite terrific pressure in the second half, we just could not get on level terms.

After today, come two difficult away matches. First is next Saturday against Watford at Vicarage Road where a tremendous crowd is expected. Stand accommodation is strictly limited but a few tickets at 9/- each are still available, but immediate application is advised. After that, we go to Barnsley on Tuesday week for the last mid-week game until the first week in November.

Once again, we must ask that most vocal section of the crowd behind the Oak Road end to moderate their language. For a couple of matches they took heed of the appeal that was made by Manager Allan Brown, but this nuisance began again in the last home match. Shout as much as you like, but please cut out the bad language which is a source of irritation to many people.



### Andy Donnelly (goalkeeper)

Born in Lanark. Signed from Weymouth August 1967. Previously played with Millwall Athletic and Clyde.

### Bobby Baxter (full back)

Born in Redcar. Signed from Brighton and Hove Albion in June 1967, where he played over 250 League and Cup games following his transfer from Darlington in 1961. Originally an inside forward at Darlington, where he was leading goalscorer for two seasons, he was converted to wing half and full back at Brighton.

### Bill Kitchener (full back)

Born in Arlesey, Beds. Joined West Ham United from school and signed Professional at 17. Joined Torquay United on temporary transfer September 1966 and played 25 games before being recalled to West Ham United in March 1967. Returned to Torquay Utd. December 1967 for a fee which has topped the previous highest fee paid for Robin Stubbs.

### Frank Mathews (full back)

Born in London. Signed from Southend United June 1968.

### John Benson (wing half)

Born in Arbroath. Signed from Manchester City, June 1964, his only other League Club.

### John Bond (wing half)

Born in Colchester. Signed from West Ham United, January 1966, his only other League Club. Holder of F.A. Cup Winners Medal 1964. Played for Football League against Scottish League 1959 and Irish League 1958. Member of F.A. South Africa Touring side 1956.

### Jimmy Dunne (wing half)

Born in Dublin. Signed from Millwall Athletic June 1967, to where he was transferred from Shelborne in 1966. Was capped for F.A. of Ireland Youth v. Germany.

### Ken Brown (centre half)

Born in Dagenham. Signed from West Ham United in May 1967. Regular First Team player for West

Ham for over ten seasons. Holder of F.A. Cup Winners Medal 1964 v. Preston North End, and European Cup Winners Medal 1965 v. Munich. Capped for England v. Ireland 1960.

### Tony Scott (winger)

Born in St. Neots. Signed from Aston Villa, September 1967. He joined West Ham United from school; was capped for England Youth 11 times. Was transferred to Aston Villa for £18,000.

### Alan Welsh (inside forward)

Born in Edinburgh. Signed from Millwall Athletic November 1967. With Millwall Athletic since 1965 and previously with Bury and Adina (one year), Bonnyrigg Rose (2 years).

### Alan Smith (inside forward)

Born in Birkenhead. Signed from Port Sunlight, a Liverpool Amateur Club in 1955.

### Patrick Morrissey (inside forward)

Born in Eire. Eire Youth and Under 23 International. Transferred from Coventry City July 1968.

### Fred Binney (inside forward)

Born in Plymouth. Signed Professional November 1966, his first League Club, having had one season with Torquay United as an Amateur. As an Amateur played for Launceston in the South Western League.






