CLUB NOTES

WITH particular warmth we welcome today our old friends from Plymouth whose fortunes are now being guided by one of our former players, Billy Bingham, whose ability has been recognised by his appointment as team manager of Ireland.

Billy, whom we signed from Sunderland for what was at that time a record fee for the Club, gained more Caps for Ireland, 56, than any other player except Danny Blanchflower, who also managed that number of appearances.

When we went to Wembley in 1959, Billy was at outside right.

Circumstances have so contrived that this is a match we simply must win because the continuing lack of success on away grounds has pushed us out of a challenging position in Division III.

That throws all the more importance on the three matches that face us, beginning today and a convincing win over Plymouth will increase confidence for Thursday's clash here with Watford.

From the way in which things are going, we can expect the biggest attendance for this match since our palmy days in the First Division. All seats in the Centre Stand were sold over a week ago and we are now more than halfway towards selling all the seats in the Wing Stand. Indications are that there will be a complete sell out before the day of the match.

Certainly, there is tremendous rivalry between the two camps with, at the moment, Watford holding the

edge over us in the promotion battle. We hope that will be remedied to some extent on Thursday.

Two days later, we face another local derby, against Northampton, on the County Ground and another big crowd is expected for this. Supporters should note that a limited number of Stand tickets are available at 10/-.

On sale, too, are the tickets, some 4,000 of them for the Cup-tie with Manchester City at Maine Road a fortnight today. These are obtainable at the Club Offices at 13/6, 11/6 and 10/- or by post enclosing remittance and stamped addressed envelope.

For the League Cup Final between Arsenal and Swindon Town on 15th March, tickets are available at Wembley Stadium at the following prices 45/- seats ; 10/- standing. Applications to the Football Box Office, Wembley Stadium Limited, Empire Stadium, Wembley, Middlesex.

Applications must include the appropriate remittance, cheques and postal orders crossed Wembley Stadium Ltd, and must be accompanied by an addressed envelope with a 4d. stamp. Tickets will not be released until 20th February, 1969.



Mike Bickle (centre forward). Signed Professional forms for Argyle, December, 1965. A local player who made a name for himself as a goal scorer for local clubs, St. Blazey and Co-op Welfare. Made 25 First Team appearances 1967/68 scoring 10 goals. Born Plymouth.

Eric Burgess. Signed from Torquay United, 1st July, 1968. Before joining Torquay was with Watford until July 1964. Born in Edgware, Middlesex.

Dave Burnside (inside forward). Born Bristol. Signed for Plymouth Argyle from Wolverhampton Wanderers on 16th March, 1968. Previously with West Bromwich Albion, Southampton and Crystal Palace. Made 12 First Team appearances season 1967/68.

Martin Clapp (goalkeeper). Signed from Coventry City, 1st July, 1968, his only League Club. Born Coventry.

Stephen Davey (wing half). Born in Plymouth. Signed as a Professional (full time) 14th July, 1966. Formerly an Apprentice Professional. Made 20 League appearances last season scoring 3 goals. Gained an England Youth XI Cap, May, 1967.

Pat Dunne (goalkeeper). Signed from Manchester United in February, 1967. Previously played for Shamrock Rovers and Everton. A Republic of Ireland International. Born in Dublin. Voted Argyle Player of the Year 1967/68 season.

John Hore (wing half). Born Foxhole, St. Austell, Cornwall. Signed Apprentice Professional forms 1962. Became a full time Professional, December 1964. A hard working and dependable player. Made 39 League appearances season 1967/68.

Duncan Neale (wing half). Born Brighton. Transferred to Argyle from Newcastle United, 1962. Made 17 League appearances last season scoring 1 goal.

Andy Nelson (centre half). Argyle secured his transfer from the Orient, October, 1965. Previous to joining the Orient, he was with Ipswich Town with which Club he helped to gain promotion to the 2nd Division of the League, and Captained the side when

they won the 1st Division Championship. Made 26 League appearances last season. Born London.

Norman Piper (wing half). Signed as an Apprentice Professional October 1963, and as a full time player in February, 1965. Formerly with Devon Amateur Club, Hatherleigh, England Youth International. 




