

CLUB NOTES

AFTER a particularly unfortunate time with the weather, there are now hopes that our programme of fixtures can go on uninterruptedly, beginning with the visit of Crewe this evening.

This is the second time the Cheshire team have made the trip south and, on the previous occasion, there was acute disappointment that the game was called off because of fog.

Curiously, we also had to make two attempts to fulfil our match with Crewe at Gresly Road and, when it did go on, we received something of a shock by being beaten.

A glance at the League Table will show that our position at the moment is that we just cannot afford to drop a single point in our attempt to overhaul the Third Division's front runners, Swindon Town and Watford.

And mention of Watford brings us once again to the subject of the troublesome section of the crowd behind the Oak Road goal.

After a period in which their behaviour improved, there has been a relapse which reached a crescendo last Wednesday when there were numerous complaints about the foul language that was being used and the obscene songs being sung.

One complainant said the situation was so bad that he took his two young sons home before the game started. Another supporter has written on the subject to the Football League, who have asked us for an explanation.

It is a matter of deep concern to the Club that a few so-called supporters who do not know how to behave, are getting the Club a bad name.

We are determined that this shall not continue and have now instructed the police that a repetition must result in the culprits being ejected from the ground and not allowed to return.

So far, we have not been even in the running for the John White award which is made monthly to the Club with the best behaved crowd and the blame for this can be laid fairly and squarely on the shoulders of the foul mouthed battalion behind the Oak Road goal.

They like to sing that they are the best supporters in the land. Now, let them prove it and, at the same time allow decent people to watch their football and enjoy it without a flood of bad language assailing their ears.

Next Saturday, the First Team is at Oldham, but we have another home fixture a week tonight when Shrewsbury Town will be the visitors.



PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

Willie Mailey (goalkeeper). Born Glasgow. A former Scottish School-boy International who started his league career with Everton, and joined the Crewe staff on March 15th, 1963. Although on the small side, he makes up for his lack of inches by his agility and daring. A most consistent performer who made maximum appearances last season with a total of 186 First Team appearances to date.

Tommy Lowry (full back). Born Liverpool. Now in his third season at Gresty Road. Although slightly built he is a keen tackler. Popularly known as “Twiggy” has made 68 First Team appearances to date.

Peter Leigh (full back). Formerly with Manchester City he is now in his eighth season at Gresty Road. Captain of the side and is an extremely popular member of the staff, being a consistent performer and a great inspiration to his colleagues. In all he has played 288 First Team games and always in the left back position. He missed only one game last season. Born Altrincham.

Neil Turner (wing half). Formerly with Blackpool and one of the close season recruits to the staff. Although mainly appearing in the Central League side he has also had some First Team experience. A six-footer who should prove a useful acquisition.

Keith Stott (centre half). First joined Crewe as an amateur in season 1964/65 and signed full time forms later the same season. He started as a centre half with the occasional game at centre forward. A strong player with a total of 107 First Team games to date. Born Atherton, Lancs.

Mick Gannon (wing half). Started his career with Everton then moved to Scunthorpe. He joined the Crewe

staff during season 1964/65 and soon established a firm place in the side. A very popular member of the staff who has just completed two successive seasons with maximum League appearances, 159 appearances to date. Born Liverpool.

Don Ratcliffe (winger). A seasoned campaigner having been with Stoke City, Middlesbrough and Darlington. Also joined Crewe in January, 1968 making his debut the same day as Kevin McHale. In his 20 games last season he showed his versatility by appearing at full back, wing half, wing and inside forward. Born Newcastle, Staffs.


Alan Bradshaw (inside forward). Born Blackburn. A schoolteacher by profession and a part-time player, now starting his fourth season at Crewe. He is a very versatile player who has appeared in all the forward positions and also at wing half. A tireless worker and usually amongst the goals.

Tommy Curley (inside forward). Born Glasgow. An experienced player who has been with Celtic, Portsmouth and Brentford. He joined Crewe staff on the opening day of season 1967/68. Plays either at wing or inside forward 18 First Team appearances.

Alan Tarbuck (winger). Now starting his second season at Crewe. A teenager who came from Everton and quickly established a place in the League side. He is a busy type of player who never gives up and who finished high up on the goals list, 31 First Team appearances.

John Inglis. Formerly with Aston Villa, another new recruit to the playing staff. Whilst at Villa Park he played mainly in the Reserve side. He should also prove to be a useful signing. Born Leven, Fife.


