



## CLUB NOTES

AS a result of the tremendous improvement that has been shown in the away form of the team, the prospect of Second Division football in Luton next season has become more than a pipe-dream.

Now, with four consecutive home matches looming up comes a great chance to further improve the situation and it is vitally important that there should be no slip up in these encounters.

Such has been the consistency shown at Kenilworth Road this season, that the prospects of winning all eight points at stake seem bright, and there should be a positive start to the task tonight by accounting for Bristol Rovers.

Not that this will be easy because Fred Ford has got together a basically young team which has not really done itself justice in League matches this season, but which showed its merit during a Cup run which ended only narrowly at Everton.

In the past, we have always found the Rovers doughty opponents, but our team, fresh from two fine away performances, should record yet another home victory with something to spare.

Especially is this the case in view of the fact, when these notes were written, there seemed a reasonable prospect that the side would be brought up to full strength.

To gain draws at Reading and Rotherham without four players who would normally have been in the team, were brilliant performances and point squarely to the fact that there is abundant reserve strength in support.

It was this knowledge that enabled Manager Alec Stock to allow the deadline date for transfers to pass without adding to his playing staff and it was a demonstration of faith in the players he has on hand.

Next Saturday sees the visit of Gillingham, whom we have already beaten twice this season, so we shall be looking for a hat-trick against the Kent club who are captained by our former player, Gordon Riddick, whose name was linked with a move to Swindon Town, but the deal did not go through before the deadline.

Another satisfying recent feature has been the vast improvement shown by the Reserves whose victory over Walsall on Saturday was their third in a row. Now, they have gone five matches without defeat and collected eight points in the process.

By virtue of the fact that we reached the last 32 of the League Cup, our Club Flag was flying at Wembley on Saturday. For the occasion we bought a new one which was partly donated by Mr. George Bryant, of Messrs. G. A. Bryant and Co., Ltd.



## PEN PORTRAITS OF OUR VISITORS

**Larry Taylor** (goalkeeper). 21 year old Exeter born goalkeeper of great promise. Joined the Club on leaving school, soon became regular Reserve Team goalkeeper. First Team debut arriving after the serious injury to Bernard Hall. Has now over 50 League appearances to his credit.

**Wayne Jones** (full back). Born in Treorchy, talented Wayne Jones joined Rovers as an amateur in 1964/65 and played in our Youth Teams for two seasons as often as possible. His progress was such that we offered him terms and he signed as a full time professional player shortly after his eighteenth birthday. Gained two Wales Under 23 Caps last season.

**Lindsay Parsons** (full back). This 21 year old Bristolian who became a professional in March, 1964 after serving as an apprentice player since leaving school. His main interest is sport.

**Stuart Taylor** (wing half). Born Bristol. Joined Rovers' amateur ranks in the summer of 1964 from a local amateur Club. Tall and commanding. He became a full time professional in April, 1967. Age 21.

**Larry Lloyd** (centre half). Born in Bristol. Signed as a professional in July, 1967 after three years as a Rovers amateur. Larry has a number of England Youth Amateur International Caps.

**John Williams** (wing half). Transferred from Plymouth Argyle in December, 1966 after spending ten years at Home Park, where he made over 500 appearances for the Devon Club. Bristol born, but has spent most of his life in Plymouth.

**Ken Ronaldson** (winger). Edinburgh born. Signed from Aberdeen in July,

1965. Tall and well built. Ken made several Scottish League appearances at Aberdeen. A natural with great power in either foot.

**Vic Barney** (inside forward). Born near Oxford and is a son of Vic Barney, a former Bristol City player. Won County and International honours at soccer as a schoolboy. Joined Rovers shortly after leaving school, completed his football apprenticeship and became a full time professional in December, 1965.

**Bobby Brown** (inside forward). Aged 19 and Bristol born. Signed for Rovers on leaving school and a regular Football Combination player last season at both wing half and inside forward positions.

**Bobby Jones** (centre forward). A popular and speedy winger, Bobby re-signed for Rovers in October, 1967 after short spells with Northampton Town and Swindon Town. One of the Eastville crowds favourites. Born Bristol.

**Harold Jarman** (winger). Joined Rovers in 1959 from a local amateur Club. Regular winger for the past six seasons and scorer of many fine goals. His main interest is sport, and is a qualified F.A. Coach. Born Bristol.






