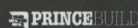

The FA Cup is the most amazing tournament. Personally, I have enjoyed the most incredible experiences as a Manager in our incredible Cup Competition. The fact about the FA Cup that is always true is that it rewards the brave and the adventurous. The Cup is about goals and excitement. It rewards the team that passes the ball and attacks relentlessly. It is everything that we stand for.

The lads deserve the credit that they have been given for an outstanding month in November. They have worked very hard and acted with consummate professionalism. We took a look at the fixtures at the beginning of the month and all agreed that we could produce 5 wins. We knew that it wouldn't be easy; Burton were flying and an away trip there was never going to be simple. Nor were games at Crewe and Scunthorpe. But, in honesty, it was the home games with Barnsley and Fleetwood that really tested us. We had to pull out all the stops.

By producing the goods, we have moved into the top 6

and we can now set about the task of climbing into the top 2, from where we can go again. We know that topping the 6 and 10 game form Leagues is a great indication of where we are at and we have to use that to motivate ourselves. Those below us know they have to be better. FIRST ROUND REVIEW

Conor Washington scored twice as Peterborough beat League One rivals Burton in the FA Cup first round.

The visitors scored before the break when Washington fired in from six yards, before the striker capitalised on a defensive error to add a second.

Jermaine Anderson added a third with a close-range finish late on, before Jack Baldwin was sent off

for Peterborough in stoppage time for a bad challenge. Phil Edwards had Burton's best chance with a header.

Posh dominated the encounter from start to finish and could have scored more on the day with Jon Taylor's long-range effort superbly tipped onto the top of the crossbar by the Burton Albion goalkeeper.

Luton reached the second round of the FA Cup after a

Josh McQuoid brace saw off League Two rivals Crawley Town. McQuoid put the Hatters ahead after the break when his 20-yard strike beat Reds goalkeeper Darryl Flahavan.

The home side restored parity soon after when Matt Harold headed in Simon Walton's cross from close range. The game looked to be heading for a replay until the final minute when McQuoid hammered in a left-footed winner into the top corner.

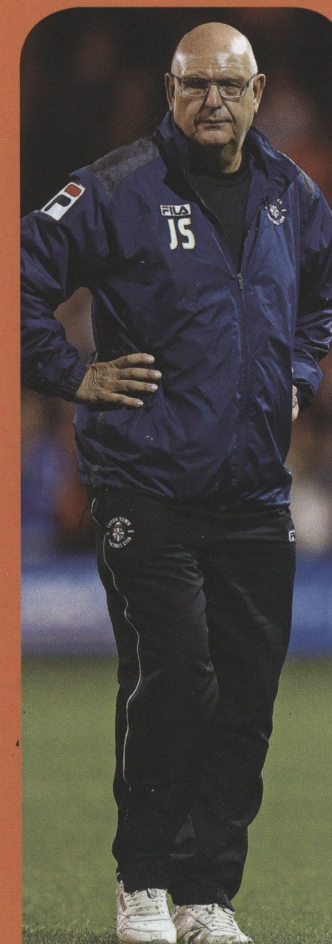


LUTON TOWN

Luton Town are the visitors to the ABAX Stadium this afternoon for this Emirates FA Cup second round tie and the Hatters will be desperate for a distraction after a poor run of form in Sky Bet League Two, with the latest 3-0 defeat at Newport County prompting some supporters to call for the head of experienced boss John Still.

The inconsistency of results has been their major failing this term. When they are good, they are very good, but unfortunately that has been few and far between this term. Conceding goals late in games has also been a problem with the home reverse to Carlisle United recently a casing point.

Of course, on paper they have an excellent side. Any squad that includes Mark Tyler, Craig Mackail-Smith and Josh McQuoid can cause problems.



Throw in another former Posh defender in Scott Griffiths and you can see why there was excitement when the draw was made.

The Hatters are also one of the best supported sides in the division and are expected to bring close to 2,000 supporters to the ABAX Stadium today.

They have a rich history in the competition as well, which makes it even more surprising that the man in charge of selecting live TV fixtures decided to ignore the country's leading goalscorers and one of the FA Cup's most memorable sides.

The teams have met once before in the FA Cup with the Hatters winning that fixture. Posh are without a win in the last five meetings between the two teams in all competition but one thing is for sure, the games have a history of goals.

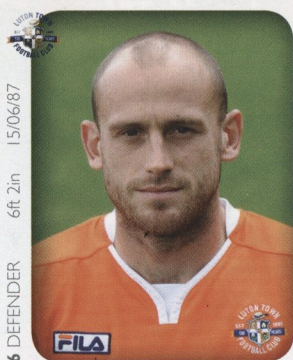




1 GOALKEEPER 5ft 11in 02/04/77

MARK TYLER

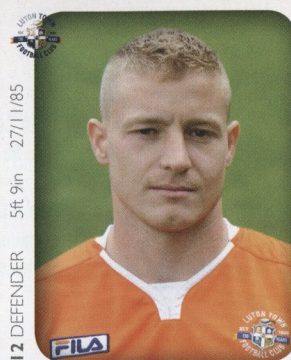

CAMERON MCGEEHAN

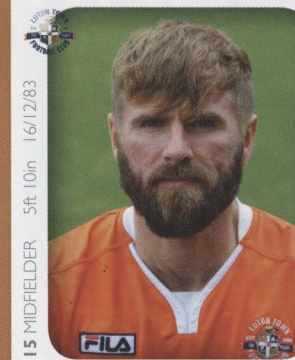

PADDY MCCOURT

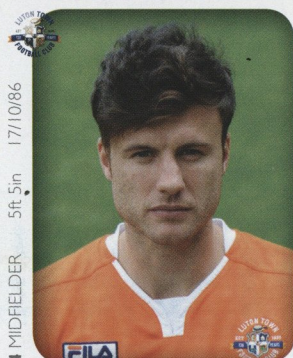

LUKE WILKINSON

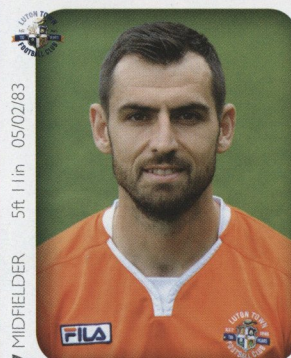

OLLY LEE

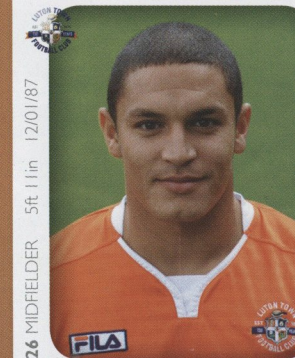

LUKE GUTTRIDGE

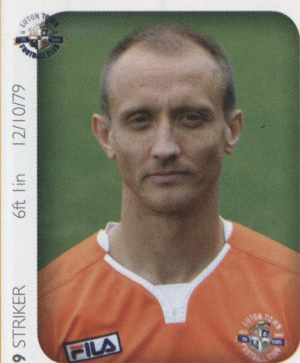

NATHAN DOYLE

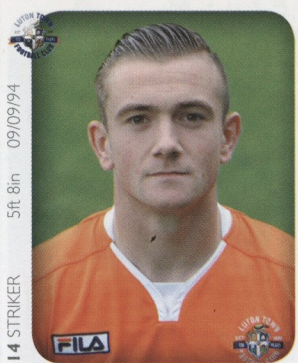

PAUL BENSON

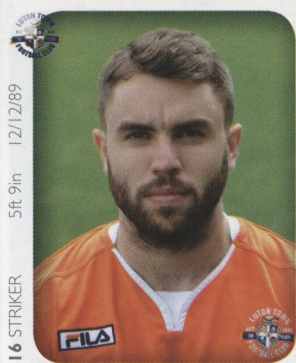

Prolific goalscorer Craig Mackail-Smith put pen to paper at Kenilworth Road a week before the start of the season having trained with the Hatters during pre-season. Another John Still find, Mackail-Smith came to prominence at Dagenham before a move to Peterborough United. He scored 99 goals in 212 games for Posh, helping them win promotion on two occasions. His goals at London Road got the forward a big money move to Brighton in 2011. He scored 10 goals in his debut season at the Amex and 11 in the next before two injury-affected campaigns followed that restricted his game-time. Now fully-fit he is reunited with Still for a second time.

POSH LEGENDS RETURN

It might not have been the season to date that he envisaged when he put pen to paper at Kenilworth Road, but today's game at the ABAX Stadium could be the turning point for front man Craig Mackail-Smith as he makes a return to the club where he scored 99 goals before his departure to Brighton and Hove Albion.

When the draw was made, it was a tie that he was already relishing and he wasn't the only one for there are four players in the Hatters ranks with links to Peterborough United and that is without boss John Still's obvious managerial links.

"It is a dream tie for me," Craig Mackail-Smith said. "When both teams won and progressed through the first round of the competition, this was the draw that I was looking for. I have been back a few times and it is very special for me. I had a wonderful time at Peterborough. I have great memories and it is a tie that I firmly believe is a bit of a standout just because of the sheer amount of connections between the two clubs. I know that Mark Tyler will be really looking forward to it. It is

interesting because we both loved our time so much so maybe it is 50-50 who is the real story!

"It should be an open tie, both sides like to go forward and score goals and I am really looking



forward to seeing everyone and hopefully myself and Tyles can have a good game," Mackail-Smith said.

Mackail-Smith returned to Posh for a short term loan stint alongside one-time strike partner Aaron Mclean during Darren Ferguson's second spell in charge of the club, but failed to add to his 99 goals for the club.

He has been on the periphery of the Luton Town side in recent weeks as the club have slid down the Sky Bet League Two table, but will be hoping for a recall against his former employees.

When the draw was concluded and Peterborough United and Luton Town had been paired together, there were a lot of cheers in the Mark Tyler household.

The 38-year-old spent 15 years at Posh between 1994-2009, playing 485 times for the club where he was handed his senior debut by now Luton boss John Still.

"I want to play every game possible no matter what the competition. Whenever there's been a cup draw

“YOU ALWAYS WANT TO GO BACK TO YOUR PREVIOUS CLUBS, ESPECIALLY TO A PLACE WHERE YOU SPENT A LARGE PART OF YOUR CAREER LIKE I DID AT PETERBOROUGH”

I've always said I wanted to go back there. You always want to go back to your previous clubs, especially to a place where you spent a large part of your career like I did at Peterborough.

"I was sitting on the sofa with my wife watching the draw – when Peterborough came out we said to each other 'that would be nice' – seconds later we both jumped off the sofa! My phone then went mental for about an hour."

It's not just Tyler who has links to the club, as along with Still, striker Craig Mackail-Smith spent four

years at Posh, while Scott Griffiths and Josh McQuoid have had stints there at the ABAX Stadium, the latter netting in the Johnstone's Paint Trophy final at Wembley.

Tyler added: "I'm not the only player with a Peterborough connection but we will have to put the emotion to one side because we'll have a job to do.

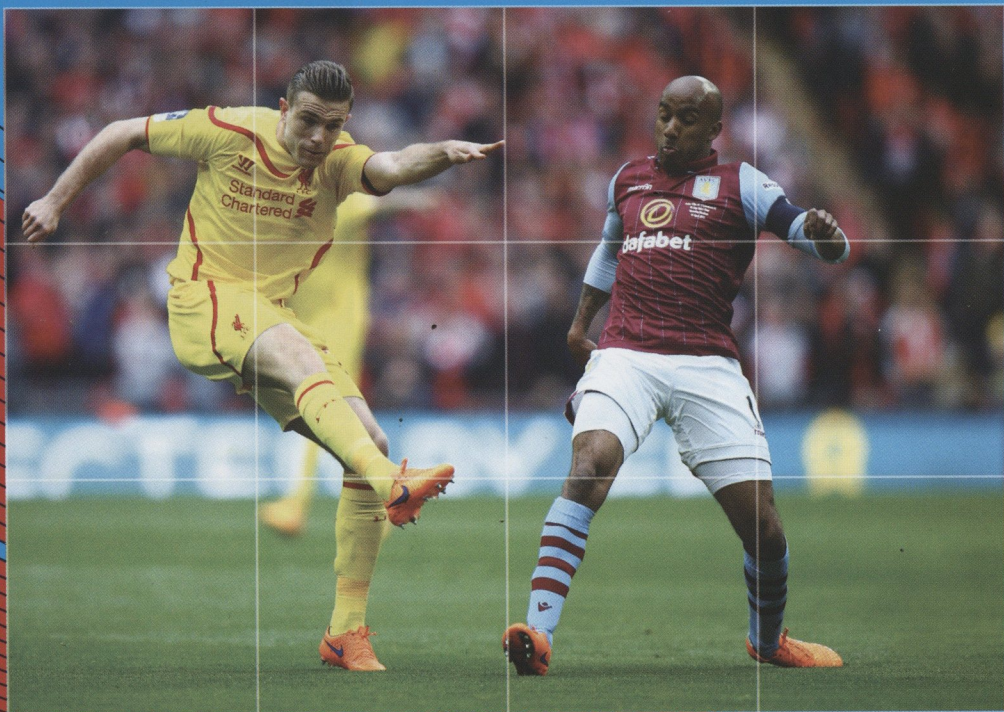
"It will be a great day for me and my family and it'll be fantastic to go back and see all the familiar faces but we want to progress into the next round of the FA Cup."

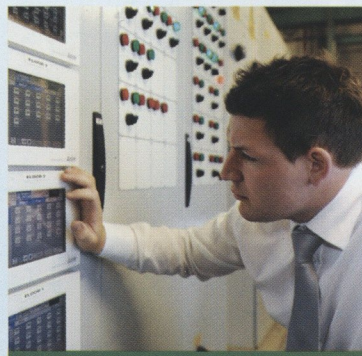

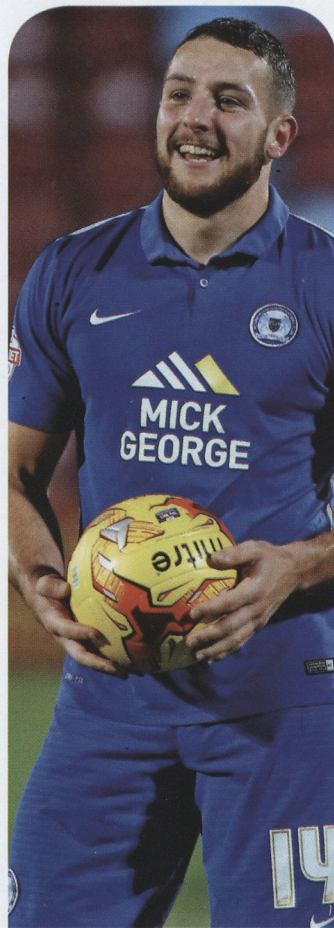
CONOR EAGER FOR MORE GOALS

The FA Cup is an inspiring competition. "That sort of competition breeds success and as a team we don't want to just win five or six games in a row, we want to stretch it to 15 or 16 games. We are playing with so much confidence it can be done, but we are not getting ahead of ourselves. We have to remain focussed on taking each game as it comes and that is the same today.

"Luton are a good side and they have players in their side that can hurt you if you are not on your game. League form can go out of the window in cup-ties, it is about

who performs the best and who is the bravest on the day. We need to make sure that is ourselves."

Washington's brace against Burton in the first round of the cup were his first goals in the competition since he turned professional. He is hoping for more cup success this afternoon.

"It would be good to have a decent cup run this year. We were knocked out early in the competition last season and that was very disappointing so hopefully we can go a bit further this time around."

GROUND REGULATIONS

Persons are admitted to this ground subject to their acceptance of the Ground Regulations and the Rules and Regulations of the Football Association and the Football League which are posted in and outside the Stadium. Entry to the ground shall constitute unqualified acceptance. The club reserves the right for stewards, servants, agents and Police to remove from the ground, any person who does not comply with these rules and regulations, or whose presence within the ground is, or could reasonably be construed as constituting a source of danger, nuisance or annoyance to any other person. Throwing of any object within the ground. Taking part in chanting of an indecent or racist nature. Entry onto the field of play or the surrounding track without lawful authority or excuse. Additionally, the use of threatening behaviour or abusive language is strictly forbidden and will result in ejection from the ground.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the unlikely event of an emergency at ABAX Stadium requiring the evacuation of all or part of the ground, spectators are requested to remain where they are, stay calm and listen for announcements over the public address system. All emergency announcements will be preceded by a distinctive chime. The announcements may direct spectators in specified areas to evacuate through exit gates to the outside of the ground, or on the pitch. Club stewards and police officers will assist in directing spectators to the safest locations. If requested to vacate a particular area in the ground, spectators should do so as calmly and quickly as possible to assist in a safe and speedy evacuation.



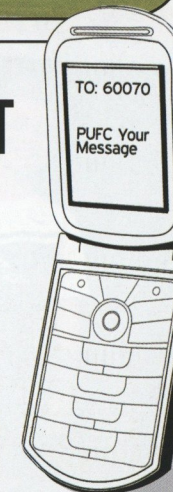
REPORT AN INCIDENT
