

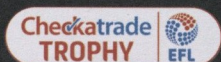

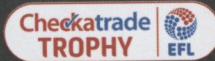

THE MANAGER NATHAN JONES

Welcome to Kenilworth Road for this rearranged Checkatrade Trophy quarter-final against Yeovil Town after the initial tie was frozen off a fortnight ago.

With the programme from the original date being issued tonight, you'll read about the background to this competition and my links to Yeovil in my notes on the page below these.

I'd like to welcome all my friends from Huish Park once again, however, and wish them a safe trip home to Somerset after the game.

Of course, we both now know that whoever wins tonight's game will host League One club Oxford United in the semi-final after they overcame Bradford City last week. The other semi-final is between Coventry City and Wycombe Wanderers.

We had a busy transfer deadline day after Christian Walton's recall by Brighton in the morning led to us putting our contingency plans into action to replace the best goalkeeper in League Two.

We welcomed Stuart Moore to the club on loan from Reading, and he played that night against Cheltenham and then again at Grimsby on

Saturday. We had to take into account, however, that Stuart would be cup-tied for this competition having played twice for Reading against tonight's opponents, so we also brought in Matt Macey on loan from Arsenal until the end of the season.

The other newcomer who made his debut as a substitute at Grimsby on Saturday is Ollie Palmer, who gives us a different option up front. We haven't had an authentic target man to be able to change our approach for certain games, or during the match itself, and with his height and physicality, Ollie gives us that.

I would like to welcome all three to Kenilworth Road, and wish those who departed – Christian, Craig Mackail-Smith, Freddie Hinds and Nathan Doyle – all the best.

On the pitch, we had the disappointment of the 3-2 home defeat by Cheltenham when our poor defending cost us the game. It has been a real strong point for us this

season though so I'm not going to dwell on it.

At Grimsby I felt we were never in any danger without being at our best, and after scoring the equaliser, there was only ever going to be one winner.

However, with late events it proved to be a missed opportunity to close the gap on the automatic promotion places once more, and these are opportunities that we can't afford to keep passing up.

We finished the game well on the front foot though, and I want us to stay that way – starting tonight in what will be another tough encounter.

Please get behind the lads as you always do, and then again on Saturday and next Tuesday as we return here to Kenilworth Road for crucial league fixtures against Crawley and Hartlepool.

THE MANAGER NATHAN JONES



Good evening and welcome back to Kenilworth Road for the first of a series of home games after spending most of 2017 so far touring the country in the league and FA Cup.

We were here a fortnight ago, of course, for the visit of Chesterfield in this competition, and the wonderful 4-0 victory we recorded that night has earned us the right to take on my old club Yeovil Town for a place in the semi-finals.

After five games against higher level opposition, it will be the first time we have faced a fellow League Two side in the Checkatrade Trophy and I would like to welcome everybody from Huish Park to Bedfordshire.

That goes to their supporters, directors, officials, management and players, among whom I have many friends from my seven years in Somerset as a player and coach. It's a club I have real affection for and the manager Darren Way and his number two Terry Skiverton are good pals, so it will be great to see them.

After the disappointment of losing at Portsmouth and Accrington Stanley, we've collected four big points from our last two league games on the road.

Crewe could prove to be a real key moment in the season, coming from behind the way we did with ten men to win 2-1.

And the form Wycombe were in before Saturday's game, there would have been many who would have taken a point from our trip to Adams Park. I was really disappointed not to take all three however, because we were comfortable at 1-0 when we were reduced to ten men again.

I was proud of how our players had stood up to the physical threat from Wycombe, but one more long ball into the box proved too much, even though we were still looking dangerous and likely to score despite being a man down.

We go again tonight, and it's another chance for some of the younger players and those who need game time to impress, so please get behind the team as you always do.

I know you've spent hundreds of pounds so far this month following us, and so soon after Christmas it is a big ask. Nearly 1,000 at Crewe and 1,800 at Wycombe is an unbelievable effort, so a massive thank you from us all.

Enjoy tonight's game.

WELCOME YEOVIL TOWN

The Hatters would like to extend a warm welcome to the staff, players and fans of Yeovil Town, who visit Kenilworth Road tonight for the second time this season.

The Glovers have put four past both of their previous opponents in the knockout stages of the Checkatrade Trophy so far this term, having defeated Reading Under-21s 4-2 and MK Dons 4-1.

Darren Way's side's progression from the group stages also saw them go without defeat, although they did miss out on a bonus point from their draw with Bristol Rovers as the League One side won the penalty shoot-out that followed.

Their other two games in Southern Group A finished with a 4-3 win over Portsmouth and a 2-0 victory in their first meeting with Reading.

Way has bolstered his squad with the signings of Cardiff City defender Tom James and forward trio Jack Storer, Brandon Goodship and Shayon Harrison, from Birmingham, Bournemouth and Spurs respectively. Goodship previously had a loan spell with the Glovers, scoring once in ten appearances.

The loans of Ben Whitfield and Matt Butcher from the Cherries have been extended until the end of the season as well, which means that all of the Huish Park outfit's signings so far this transfer window have been under the age of 22.

Yeovil's league form has been a little bit topsy turvy of late, having not won a league game since the beginning of December – a 5-0 thrashing of Crawley Town – but they have also come up against some of the high-flyers of League Two in that run. That includes a narrow defeat to Carlisle and earning a point against both Wycombe Wanderers and Portsmouth.

THE BOSS

DARREN WAY



After spending five years working his way up the coaching ladder with

the Glovers, the 37-year-old former Yeovil midfielder took the reins as full-time boss in 2015, following their relegation from the third tier.

BETWEEN THE STICKS

JONNY MADDISON

The stopper arrived from Leicester City in the summer, signing a one-year-deal at Huish Park. He previously had loan spells with likes of Crawley Town and Leamington.

IN DEFENCE

BEVIS MUGABI

The 21-year-old joined from Southampton in the summer and has been a regular in Darren Way's side this season.

ALEX LACEY

After making over 50 appearances for the Hatters, Lacey joined Yeovil in 2015. Whilst with the Town, he enjoyed loan spells with Cambridge City, Thurrock, Eastbourne Borough and Eastleigh.

NATHAN SMITH

The full-back joined the Glovers for a second time in 2014 and now the 30-year-old has made well over 200 appearances for the Somerset club. He also has two caps for Jamaica.

RYAN DICKSON

The 30-year-old counts Yeovil as his ninth club since he began his career with Plymouth. His other former sides include Southampton, Brentford and Crawley Town.

LIAM SHEPHARD

Now in his third loan spell from Swansea City, the 22-year-old has made one appearance for his parent club – a 3-2 defeat to Oxford United.

ACROSS THE MIDDLE

KEVIN DAWSON

A part of the side that reached the Championship in 2013, the 26-year-old joined the Glovers, originally on trial, after seeing out his contract with League of Ireland side Shelbourne.

ALEX LAWLESS

A former favourite on the Town terraces, Lawless made over 200 appearances for the Hatters before departing for the Glovers last summer.

MATT BUTCHER

The 19-year-old extended his loan deal with Glovers until the end of the season, after joining from Bournemouth in the summer.

MATT DOLAN

Now in his third season with Yeovil, the 23-year-old counts Bradford City, Hartlepool and Middlesbrough as his former teams.



OTIS KHAN

The attacking midfielder has been in excellent form since his arrival at Huish Park in the summer, after his departure from Barnsley. Currently top scorer with seven goals.

UP FRONT

FRANCOIS ZOKO

The former Stevenage, Blackpool and Notts County striker joined Yeovil at the start of last season as they began their first term back in the fourth tier of English football.

JACK STORER

The forward joined from Birmingham City a fortnight ago having made a handful of appearances for the Blues.

BEN WHITFIELD

Another to extend his loan spell from Bournemouth until the end of the season, the striker has notched two goals for his current side so far this term.

STORY OF THE MATCH:

The Hatters moved to within two rounds of Wembley after turning in a four-midable performance to knock yet another higher-level side out of the Checkatrade Trophy.

Chesterfield might be involved in a League One relegation battle and were without a permanent manager following the sacking of former Town hero Danny Wilson two days before the game, but the Hatters showed no mercy to leave the visitors from Derbyshire in disarray.

Craig Mackail-Smith netted his first goal in almost 11 months, Jack Marriott bagged a double and substitute Isaac Vassell scored an emphatic fourth to send the Spireites the same way as Gillingham, West Brom and

Swindon, as the Town booked a place in the quarter-finals.

Mackail-Smith fired home from the penalty spot after he had been tripped by Laurence Maguire as the striker closed in on goal. Two minutes later Marriott doubled the lead with a smart shot that caught out Lloyd Allinson in the Chesterfield net, an advantage the hosts maintained until half-time.

Marriott struck again six minutes after the restart, shooting across Allinson into the bottom right corner, before Vassell confirmed the result with a powerful run and finish four minutes from time.



JONES: From the word go we really went for the jugular

"It was wonderful, a bit more like us. After the weekend at Accrington when we weren't really at it, that was a team that was right at it. From the word go we really went for the jugular.

"We pressed high and we had a load of energy about us. We scored a goal from a real good through ball and pace.

"The second goal was exactly the same, the fourth one was exactly the same and it could have been more, without being disrespectful.

"We had opportunities to put the game to bed a lot earlier, but I am delighted. It's lifted me after the weekend.

"We have paid them all the respect that is due, because they have got some real good players, some real good individuals. They are going through a tough time at the minute, but we couldn't be complacent in what we had to do.

"I thought it was an excellent performance, full of energy and real desire to do well. At times they had a lot of the ball in the second half, but they didn't break us down, not once."
