## THE MANAGER



Good evening and welcome to Kenilworth Road for tonight's second group match in this season's Checkatrade Trophy – and our second game of the campaign against Barnet.

I'd like to welcome everybody making the short trip north London – directors, officials, supporters, their manager Rossi Eames, his staff and their players – and I hope they have a safe journey home after the game.

We know that Barnet can be dangerous opponents having suffered a 1-0 defeat at The Hive in our second league game of the season, a day when we never really found any fluency in our game.

The squad has started to gel since then, however, and we come into this match in excellent form having won four of our last five league games, a run in which we are unbeaten.

Some of our play in the win over Newport County on Saturday, especially in the first half, was outstanding. I don't think that's an exaggeration because without being disrespectful to Newport, the lead at half-time should have been even more convincing than 3-0.

We got the goals through Alan Sheehan and Danny Hylton, who netted twice and is now fully fit after missing pre-season. But we also hit the post and should have had a second penalty when Danny was brought down, as well as getting into countless good positions to produce a killer final ball.

Newport came into it for about a 15-minute period after they scored, but we defended well – not just the defence but as a team, because we dealt with a lot of set-pieces – and could have added more as the game went on.

Your support on Saturday was wonderful, as always, and I know that although the crowd won't be as big tonight as for a league game, you will get behind the players on the pitch.

As has been the case in the Checkatrade Trophy since I've been at the club, we'll use the match to give some valuable experience to some younger players and game time to others who maybe haven't played as much recently, but our team will be a strong one.

The one thing we always do is treat the competition with the utmost respect. We've seen some fine adverts for the Checkatrade Trophy here over the past year and after the excellent game against Spurs U21s in August, I'm sure tonight will prove to be another.

Enjoy the game.

# WELCOME BARNET

The Town would like to extend a warm welcome to this evening's visiting staff, players and supporters of Barnet.

Labelled as one of the 'potential surprise packages' this season by Nathan Jones, the Bees have already got one over the Hatters this term having beaten them 1-0 back in August at the Hive. Their form since that result has been inconsistent, however, with Saturday's 3-1 defeat at Wycombe leaving them 18th in the Sky Bet League Two table.

Rossi Eames' team have won two, drawn one and lost six since the victory over the Hatters, but have now gone five games without a win,

including four defeats. They have found goals relatively easy to come by, scoring one goal in each of those last five fixtures, but have only picked up a solitary point.

However, the Bees' top scorer for the past three seasons, John Akinde – having netted 83 times in 145 appearances for the Hive outfit – has been out injured since the start of this term.

His return may well make a difference to recent form, although the man currently leading the north Londoners'

line, summer signing Shaquille Coulthirst, has filled in ably – his eight goals in 14 appearances making him one of the early favourites to win the Sky Bet League Top Scorer accolade.

The North London based side started their campaign off in the Checkatrade Trophy with a home defeat – an entertaining game though, as Eames' side twice took the lead, only to eventually lose 4-3 to AFC Wimbledon – who ahead of tonight's games sit top the Southern Group F Table.

## IN BETWEEN THE STICKS

### CRAIG ROSS



The stopper signed for Barnet on a one-year deal following his release from Vanarama National League outfit Macclesfield Town in the summer. The 27-year-old was offered a new contract by the Silkmen – for whom he made over 30 appearances for last season – but opted to join Rossi Eames' side. The keeper counts Eastbourne Borough, Cambridge United and Whitehawk as his former sides as he worked his way up from the Non-League game.

## THE MAN IN THE MIDDLE

### MAURO VILHETE

A Barnet youth academy product, Vilhete has gone onto make over 200 career appearances since making his debut in 2010, becoming the Bees' youngest ever appearance maker aged 16 – a record he held until 2014. The wide man is the Hive outfit's top scoring midfielder this season with three goals to his name so far. He has also been sent on loan to Hendon and Boreham Wood during his time with Barnet.



## THE DANGERMAN


### SHAQUILE COULTHIRST

A Tottenham Hotspur academy graduate, the 22-year-old left White Hart Lane having made only one appearance. During his time there he was sent out on loan to five different clubs including Southend United and York City, before signing permanently for Peterborough United in 2016. He played 16 times for Posh during the first half of last season, but was loaned out to Mansfield Town for the second, netting five times in 20 appearances. He has already broken his goal record for a season, having scored eight times in all competitions.

### CHARLIE CLOUGH



The defender joined the Bees for an undisclosed fee back in January and has been a regular since his arrival. He started his professional career off at Bristol Rovers – making a handful of appearances for the Pirates, heading out on a number of loans to the likes of Chippenham Town, Weymouth and Bath City. He moved permanently to Dorchester Town in 2012, before climbing back up the league tables, eventually back into the EFL when he was signed by Barnet from Forest Green Rovers.
