

to have to eradicate that.


### Impressive



To date almost 100 players have been signed into our development programme through the Skills programme, which has proved our most successful recruitment tool in the past. The cost is £45 per nine-week term, which includes practical sessions and one assessment match.

In addition to the trial match, all players receive a report on their personal development during the programme. If our coach feels you have shown the right levels of ability and attitude during the term, you will be given the opportunity to progress to the Centre of Excellence/Pre-Academy. Players who display talent can be moved through the programme after only a few weeks if appropriate.

# WELCOME

## BRIGHTON & HOVE ALBION U21s



The Hatters would like to extend a warm welcome to the visiting players, staff and supporters of Brighton & Hove Albion Under-21s.

**Plying their trade in Premier League 2 Division One** after promotion last season, the Seagulls are managed by former Boston United, York City and Crawley Town man Simon Rusk. The ex-midfielder took over in March 2015, having previously been in charge of the club's under-18s.

The young Seagulls opened their campaign with three successive draws prior to Friday night's emphatic 5-0 win over Manchester City.

The ties between Brighton and the Town are quite strong, given Nathan Jones' playing and coaching stint with the club, as well as Glen Rea, who came through the youth ranks on the south coast. He

made two appearances for the club, both of which came in the League Cup, whilst Jones played over 150 times during a five-year stint.

One of the 12 invited Premier League clubs into the Trophy this campaign, the AMEX Stadium based outfit are entering their third year in the competition, having reached the third round in the 2016/17 season, before exiting at the group stages last year.

New rules in place this year means Rusk can only select two players who are over the age of 21 and have made more than 40 first-time career appearances.

### TOM MCGILL

AGE: 18

Ex-England U17 international goalkeeper who is on loan to Non-League Worthing for the season, but is eligible for Checkatrade Trophy action.

## HUGO KETO

AGE: 20

The 20-year-old signed for the Seagulls from Arsenal in July, penning a two-year deal at the AMEX. The stopper has three under-21 caps for Finland.

## BILLY COLLINGS

AGE: 20

A signing from Reading in January 2017, the 20-year-old has made one appearance in the Premier League 2 Division 2 for Brighton.

## DEFENDERS:

### JOSH KERR

AGE: 20

The former Celtic man joined Brighton in the summer of 2017. He spent five years with the Bhoys, winning the SFA Youth Cup.

## WARREN O'HORA

AGE: 19

The Irishman joined in January this year from Bohemians. A Republic of Ireland under-19 international, he penned a deal at the AMEX that runs until 2020.

## BEN WHITE

AGE: 20

The 20-year-old was a regular for Newport County AFC last season in an impressive loan stint at Rodney Parade, having played a handful of times for the first team at Brighton.

## GEORGE COX

AGE: 20

After penning his first professional contract with the club in June 2016, the 20-year-old has gone onto be a regular for the Seagulls' under-23 side.

## JOE TOMLINSON

AGE: 18

A summer signing from Yeovil Town, the 18-year-old was a part of the Glovers' under-18 side, having begun his career at Southampton.

## OWEN MOORE

AGE: 19

A versatile player who can play in defence or midfield, the 19-year-old signed from Arsenal in July 2015.

## LEO OSTIGARD

AGE: 19

A recent arrival from Norwegian Eliteserien side Molde FK, the 19-year-old signed a three-year deal with the Seagulls. A Norway under-19 international.

## MIDFIELDERS:

### MAX SANDERS

AGE: 19

A regular in the under-23s for Brighton, the 19-year-old was captain on a number of occasions last season.

## JAYSON MOLUMBY

AGE: 19

The 19-year-old has already played at Kenilworth Road, having been involved in the Seagulls' pre-season friendly here in 2016.

## WILL COLLAR

AGE: 21

Converted from a right-back to a central midfielder, the 21-year-old penned his first professional contract with the club in July 2015.



## MATHIAS NORMANN

AGE: 22

Signed from Norwegian second division side FC Bodo/Glimt last year, he has spent time on loan at Molde FK.

## JORDAN DAVIES

AGE: 20

Signed from Wrexham in January 2017 for undisclosed terms, the winger has also played for Welsh Premier League side Bangor City.

## PETER GWARGIS

AGE: 20

The signing from Swedish second-tier side

Jonkopings Sodra IF celebrates his 20th birthday today, having joined the Seagulls last month.

## ANDERS DREYER

AGE: 20

Another Scandinavian signing, the 20-year-old joined from Danish Superliga side Esbjerg in August. Capped for Denmark from under-17 up to Under 20 level.

## DANNY MANDROIU

AGE: 19

Having progressed through the ranks at the AMEX, the Irishman moved to England in 2015, but missed a large portion of last season through injury.

## STRIKERS:

### AARON CONNOLLY

AGE: 18

The forward made his first team debut for Brighton in August last year, coming on against Barnet in the EFL Cup. Has represented Ireland at under-17 and under-19 level.



## STEFAN LJUBICIC

AGE: 18

The 18-year-old came to England from Iceland in July 2016 and went straight into their under-18s side. He made 18 Premier League South appearances last season, scoring ten times and claiming four assists.

## VIKTOR GYOKERES

AGE: 20

Signed from Swedish club IF Brommapojkarna in September 2017, Gyokeres was joint-top scorer in the 2017 UEFA European Under-19 Championship, scoring three goals for his country.

## JAMES TILLEY

AGE: 20

Signed a professional contract with Brighton in 2015, going onto establish himself as a key player in the Under-23s side.
